Thanks for wanting to learn more about SABER, the Single Automated Business Exchange for Reporting.

SABER's mission is to collect business status from companies to save them time and effort reporting to governments. And to provide that status to governments for them to incorporate into their own software to improve situational awareness and resource allocation. The objective of this information exchange is to influence government and business-to-business recovery priorities by providing accurate and timely business status information about the commercial sector in order to get businesses back in business faster.

Getting SABER status is free, but we do ask you to enroll in SABER and check the box allowing us to list your organization's name on the SABER website. That way we work with your team to get SABER business status into your emergency management or common operating picture software you use already.

We can also help you get the businesses you want to provide their status through SABER. If you identify those businesses we can work together to contact and enroll them. Together we can get business status from the companies that matter to you.
