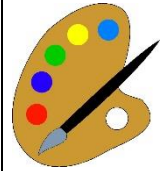

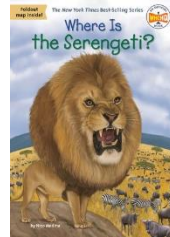

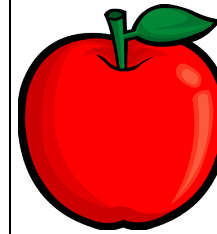

mask. String Art Painting.



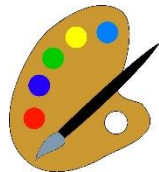

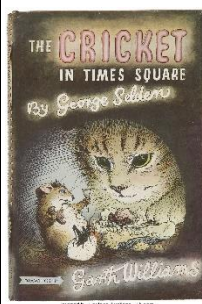
