When Ken Henderson and Joe Seiler began the Richmond / Ermet Aid Foundation in 1995 and producing these concerts, they could not have imagined how many lives have been affected, touched and made better due to their ability to bring the community, performers and the many beneficiaries together to give back and raise money for a myriad of worthy causes. To date REAF has raised well over \$4.5 million dollars to support AIDS/HIV services, hunger programs and programs for homeless and disenfranchised youth and seniors. In those 30 years, all of the performers and volunteers have donated their time and talents to be part of this philanthropic organization. All of the money generated by ticket sales have always gone directly to the beneficiaries.

The 30th Anniversary gala on Sun. July 14, 2024 is particularly special this year because of the following highlights:

- Bruce Vilanch – one of the most respected comedy writers will be receiving the **REAF Performer Lifetime** Achievement Award. Bruce has performed at countless REAF benefits over the years and delighted audiences with his wit, pathos and activism with his devotion to AIDS causes.

Many of the cast members for this 30th Anniversary Gala – including **Paula West, Lisa Vroman, Jason Brock, David Burnham** and **Debby Boone** have been ongoing supporters of REAF and have appeared in many benefits over the years and always have donated their talent and time.

Sam Harris – Broadway and TV actor, who was the first winner on "Star Search" and supporter of many charities is making with comeback with his first performance in 3 years since being impacted by COVID.

In 1995, the two women decided not to get mad but get even when they launched a musical AIDS benefit to honor their sons by raising funds for AIDS service organizations.
