The 17<sup>th</sup> St. Patrick died 461.

The 18<sup>th</sup> Saint Cyril of Jerusalem died 386. Writer and teacher.

19<sup>th</sup> Fourth Sunday of Lent, Rose vestments. Second preparation of RCIA. Jesus heals.

The 20<sup>th</sup> St. Joseph Spouse of the Blessed Virgin. The Vernal Equinox which begins the days to count for Easter.
