## Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

- Habakkuk 1:2–3; 2:2–4 How long, Lord, will you make me witness misery?
- Psalm 95 “If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.”
- 2 Timothy 1:6–8, 13–14 Guard the rich deposit of faith you were given.
- Luke 17:5–10 When you have done everything for the kingdom, do more.

The prophet Habakkuk cries out to God in frustration, upset that nothing is being done about the discord and violence in Judah. “Patience,” God answers. The apostles cry out to Jesus, complaining their faith isn’t strong enough. “You have plenty,” Jesus assures them. May we not be too timid to cry out to God in our need, may we listen for God’s reassuring voice, and, as we sing in the psalm, may we harden not our hearts.

#### Order Of Christian Initiation Of Adults

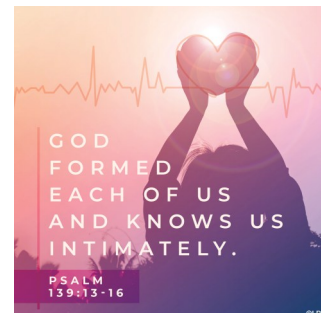

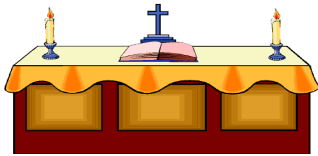
