1. **visionary**: having or marked by foresight and imagination
2. **immutable**: not capable of or susceptible to change
3. **ideological**: based on or relating to a system of ideas and ideals, especially concerning economic or political theory and policy.
4. **stringent**: strict, precise, and exacting.
5. **abstruse**: difficult to understand; obscure.
6. **tirade**: a long, angry speech of criticism or accusation.
7. **aggregate**: a whole formed by combining several (typically disparate) elements.
8. **avocation**: a hobby or minor occupation.
9. **eulogy**: a speech or piece of writing that praises someone or something highly, typically someone who has just died.
10. **hyperbole**: exaggerated statements or claims not meant to be taken literally; extravagant exaggeration
