OpenAI set to open first India office by year-end

(Agency) New Delhi: OpenAI said it will set up its first India office in New Delhi later this year, underlining the swift uptake of its AI tools in a market that is ChatGPT's second-largest after the US and among its fastest-growing. OpenAI said it has officially established an entity in India and has begun hiring a dedicated local team.

Opening an office in India reflects OpenAI's support for IndiaAI's mission and commitment to partnering with the government to build AI for India, with India, it said in a statement. The move will also enable OpenAI to better serve its users in India, including millions of students, educators, professionals, and developers who use its tools to learn, be more creative, and solve problems for themselves and others.

This expansion, it said, underscores India's global leadership in AI, its thriving ecosystem, and the growing demand for



OpenAI's advanced tools among people, developers, and businesses across the country. Data cited by OpenAI highlighted India as a leading country for AI adoption. Weekly active users of ChatGPT in India increased more than four times in just the past year. The country also ranks among the top five developer markets globally on the OpenAI platform. India also has the largest population of students on ChatGPT worldwide.

Seafood exports remain flat in 2024-25 at \$7.45 billion

(Agency) New Delhi: The country's seafood exports remained flat at \$7.45 billion during 2024-25, the Commerce Ministry said. According to the Ministry's statement on June 19 last year, India's seafood exports of 17,81,602 tonne in 2023-34 were worth Rs.60,523.89 crore (\$7.38 billion). The shipments in volume terms, however, dipped to 16,98,170 tonne last fiscal year. According to the Ministry's statement on June 19 last year, India's seafood exports of 17,81,602 tonne in 2023-34 were worth Rs.60,523.89 crore (\$7.38 billion). India



shipped 16,98,170 tonne of seafood worth Rs.62,408.45 crore (\$7.45 billion) during 2024-25, the Ministry said.

Among the seafoods, frozen shrimp remained the major exported item in terms of quantity and value while the U.S. and China turned out to be the major importers of India's seafood. The exports stood at \$5.17 billion, accounting for a share of 43.67% in quantity and 69.46% of the total dollar earnings. Frozen fish, the second largest exported item, fetched \$622.60 million. It was followed by frozen squid (\$367.68 million).

The Ministry said that the U.S. continued to be the major importer of Indian seafood in value terms, with an import worth \$2.71 billion as against \$2.55 billion in 2023-24.

Highway snobbery takes a toll

(Agency) New Delhi: As Prime Minister Narendra Modi delivered his twelfth speech from the ramparts of the Red Fort, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) unveiled an annual toll pass. Indians can now use existing Fastag accounts to buy an annual pass for Rs 3,000, which will be valid for 200 toll payments on national highways and expressways. More than half a million passes were sold in gave kudos to Nitin Gadkari, who handles the relevant ministry, for his infrastructure push. But every silver lining has a cloud behind it. A three-judge bench of the Supreme Court came down with a ton of bricks on the NHAI. To summarize, there is a national highway stretch in Thrissur district in Kerala, where travellers are forced to pay toll even though the roads are in a state of terrible disrepair.

(Agency) Kolkata: Despite increasing digitalisation, writing instruments maker Linc Ltd. is aiming to achieve a 15-20 per cent compound annual growth rate (CAGR) for five years, a top company official said.

The Kolkata-based company has around Rs 550 crore of revenue at present, with core operating profitability EBITDA (earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortisation) at 11 per cent, he said. We plan to grow at 15 per cent to 20 per cent CAGR for four to five years. The operating profitability is 11 per cent with revenue at Rs 550 crore.

The sleeping giant of green energy: Why this PSU is on the cusp of a rare growth cycle

(Agency) New Delhi: This PSU, often dismissed as a slow-moving company, is emerging as a stealth green energy play with one of India's largest renewable pipelines. A wave of delayed projects are finally nearing completion, setting up a rare growth cycle in earnings.

But the real surprise may come from a company most investors still dismiss as an old-world dam builder, NHPC, formerly known as National Hydro Electric Power Corporation. It built dams, earned regulated equity and sent out predictable dividend cheques.

Nothing more, nothing less. Investors could set

their watch to its earnings. Yet, now the script seems to be changing. This is thanks to a string of projects long stuck in the pipeline, finally reaching



the finish line. If execution holds, NHPC could be on the cusp of a rare growth cycle.

Hydropower is often seen as yesterday's story. It takes decades to build a dam, costs balloon and nature always has the fi-

nal say.

In contrast, solar and wind farms pop-up in months. That is why NHPC has often been left out of the clean energy conversation. But look at its capacity. NHPC runs 30 power stations with 8,140 MW (megawatt) of installed capacity. Of this, 7,771 MW is hydro, and the rest is renewable through solar and wind. It contributes 16% of India's hydro capacity.

The future pipeline is even more striking. Nearly 46,000 MW is under various stages of construction, clearance or investigation. This includes not just dams but pumped storage projects and solar parks.

CCPA imposes Rs.3 lakh fine on VLCC for misleading ads on slimming treatments

(Agency) New Delhi: The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has imposed Rs.3 lakh fine on VLCC Ltd. for publishing misleading advertisements related to slimming treatments.

The Department of Consumer Affairs said the penalty has been imposed on VLCC for publishing misleading advertisements regarding fat-loss

and slimming treatments through the use of the U.S.-FDA approved CoolSculpting procedure/machine. On examination, it was found that VLCC was making exaggerated claims of drastic weight loss and inch reduction within a single session, which went far beyond the actual approval granted to the CoolSculpting machine, thereby misleading consumers. CC's advertisements projected CoolSculpting and related procedures as a permanent weight-loss and size-reduction solution. CCPA imposed a penalty of Rs.3 lakh on VLCC and also issued certain advisories which should be strictly followed in its future advertisements.
