This Brand Ambassador Workshop is a hands-on workshop for artists of all levels and experience from beginner to professional. Along with the instructor Andrea Walker, this guided workshop is a learning experience where participants have the opportunity to experiment with and learn about many different materials. The Watermedia Workshop will focus on Holbein's Watercolor, Gouache, Acrylic Gouache, and Watercolor Mediums, as well as Legion's Stonehenge Aqua and Yupo papers, and an assortment of General Pencil materials. All participants will take home free samples!
