## Rules and Regulations

**Fees:** Payment for entry must be made in full at the time of entry, made payable to the Southbury Women's Club. Checks with insufficient funds will be subject to a \$20 return check fee.

The application for entry must be received by August 30, 2019.

**Eligibility:** The entrant must be an amateur baker, over 16 years old to participate. The entrant does not need to be a resident of Southbury.

Only one pie entry per person. Entries will be processed in the order they are received, and space is limited. Submit your application early to ensure a spot in the competition.

Pies will be displayed outdoors, without refrigeration, for the duration of the event. For this reason, no custard-based or other pies requiring refrigeration (ex. Pumpkin, cream, etc.) can be accepted. Judges reserve the right to not taste a pie they believe may be unsafe for consumption, and entrant will become ineligible for the prize of "Most Scrumptious".

Pies should not be larger than a standard 10" dish and no taller than 6".

Pies must be delivered to the judging tent at Stibb's Field at the Southbury Training School on September 7th between 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM on the day of the event. Any entrants that do not deliver their pie before 11:00 AM will forfeit their spot in the competition.

**Judging:** Judging will occur at 3:00 PM on the day of the event. Entrants do not need to be present to win.

Prizes will be awarded for:

"Best Dressed"

"Most Scrumptious"

"Crowd Favorite" (to be selected by event patrons)

Prizes will be \$50 in gift cards donated by local restaurants.
