Support & Compensation

To ensure success in this contract position, we offer substantial support, including introductory and on-going training and access to a Service Coordinator who is on call and available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week when assistance, direction, and advocacy are needed. Should there be a need for it, housing modifications for wheelchair and walker accessibility can possibly be supplied.
