

# ***Crooked Creek Trap Club***

## ***Meeting Minutes***

April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018

### **I. Call to order**

Pat Willman called to order the regular meeting of the Crooked Creek Trap Club at 6:35pm on 4/2/2018 at Mountain Parks Electric.

### **II. Roll call**

Audrey conducted a roll call. The following persons were present: Pat Willman, Dick Doucette, Audrey Beisel, Kimberlee Karr and team captains.

### **III. Approval of minutes from last meeting**

Audrey read the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were approved as read by Kimberlee and second by Pat, all in favor.

### **IV. Treasurer Report**

The cash balance on November 29, 2017 was \$26,199.21.

Deposits made in the months of December, January, February, and March totaled \$824.34 (largest deposit was remaining cash in boxes).

Expenses paid in the months of December, January, February, and March totaled \$643.02 (two largest expenses--Sears and Property Tax).

Our current balance is \$26,379.45.

Insurance paid: 3/26/2018 \$3048.80.

New Balance: \$23,330.65

- a) Team packets, handed out and contents explained by Kimberlee
- b) Mandatory Volunteer Days- Each team needs to sign up for one Sunday and at least one team member must show up for volunteer hours or they will be disqualified from the shoot off, or team can sign up for a project needing to be done, or they can just pay \$200 to not volunteer.
  - i) Pat and Kimberlee will make a list of projects to be done.
- c) NRA membership- Now 3,5, life, or distinguished memberships are available to purchase through the trap club.
- d) CCTC Work Day – work day to be April 21<sup>st</sup> weather permitting, then open the next day (postpone 1 week if bad weather)
  - i) May open some stuff up before work day, email will be sent out.
- e) Handicap – Teams shooting with less than 5 shooters
  - i) Take highest score to be used for missing shooter to calculate handicap only. Handicap will be recorded to help with Shoot-Off placement in bracket.
- f) Ham Shoot – June 16<sup>th</sup>, schedule one week after Blue Valley shoot.
  - i) There will be 4 hams each awarded for trap, skeet and 5-stand; all other hams will be awarded for games.
  - ii) Max amount of won per person is 2, to allow for others the chance to win.
- g) Shotgun for 4H kids- Taura has asked for volunteers to help work with the 4H kids on Monday nights @ 5pm.
- h) Closing Date for Club- looking to schedule an actual closing date for the club and have a work day to clean up and close down for the season, will be discussed at next meeting.
- i) Punch Cards- Blue cards are now expired, Pink cards are still good for just this year, and Yellow cards will be new this year.
- j) Range Officer Meeting – will be either April 22<sup>nd</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup> @ 10am depending on weather.

  - ii) Peak will donate or give gravel at a reduced price.

  - v) Will have paper targets and clays available for purchase to shoot.
  - vi) Looking to have done early spring.
