

## **Civic Report**

The Public Works Department met with the Events Center Board on 5/10/2017. Brad Underwood reports that there is still high interest from the Events Center Board for building the SSO on Events Center property. The City is moving forward to purchase an easement on the property (this prevents the land being used for other purposes) and the City is working with the Events Center to plan construction around ongoing site improvements. Currently, the agreement is with the city attorney to finalize terms. The final decision on the site will be bought to the Public Works Commission and City Council over the June/July period.

#### Traffic Action Plan (TAP)

The Board has drafted a TAP document based on the Traffic Action Plan Committee recommendations and feedback

from residents at two FGHA meetings. This will act as a reference document for the City outlining what changes the residents in Fiesta Gardens would like to see and those which are not viewed as beneficial for our community. These will be posted on the FGHA website. We are in the process of setting up meetings with those at the City to ensure we have an open line of communication regarding plans and progress to keep everyone in Fiesta Gardens informed.

Work orders for the first changes are already in the works at the City: Buses will no longer be allowed to make a left turn traveling west on 19<sup>th</sup> Ave onto Ginnever. This is designed to prevent the Google buses cutting through our neighborhood to get to the Events Center parking lot.

We have noticed increased police enforcement at the 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Grant intersection. If you do continue to see issues with cars blocking the intersection or dangerous driving, please call SMPD (650-522-7700) to report problems and request enforcement.

By the time you read this the Maker Faire will have come and gone. Please let us know your experience with traffic and parking so we can give feedback to SMPD to try to improve things next year.

### FGHA BOARD MEETING – April 4, 2017

The Board Meeting, which was held at Fiesta Gardens Pool Cabana, was called to order at 7:09pm. Board Members in attendance were: Joe D'Agostino-President, Roland Bardony-Parks, Pascale Stemmle-Social Director, Mike Russell-Pool Maintenance and Steve Muller-Vice President. Steve Stanovcak-Pool Operations and Rich Neve-Civic, were not present.

**March Minutes**: On a motion duly made and seconded and approved by all board members present, the minutes of the March 7, 2017 meeting were approved.

#### Financial - Christina Forrest

- There was no budget for 02/2017 financial statement, but using the 2016 budget, we are on course.
- The assessment invoices went out and payments are being submitted by members.
- The lifeguard pay schedule has been submitted to Steve Stanovcak-Pool Operations for his approval.
- We are out to bid on insurance that is expiring in May 2017.

#### President - Joe D'Agostino

- Joe introduced Greg St. Clair, who brought two guests from the San Mateo United Homeowners Association to speak about matters involving Fiesta Gardens Homes Association.
- Anna Kuhre- introduced herself and reported on the following items:
  - Sewage Tank: The City of San Mateo will not be considering Fiesta Gardens Meadow Park as a selection to place the Sewage Tank. The City has decided to place the sewage tank at the Event Center.
  - Saratoga Drive Wall: The City of San Mateo has no plans to open the wall up on Saratoga Drive.
  - Traffic Issues: Board needs to get a consensus from Fiesta Gardens Homes Association on what traffic issues to bring to the City of San Mateo.
- Eric Rodriguez-introduced himself and spoke about current traffic issues affecting Fiesta Gardens Homes Association. He is running for City Council.

#### **Open Forum**:

• Residents in attendance discussed neighborhood traffic issues and possible solutions.

Vice President - Steve Muller: had nothing to report.

**Civic** - Rich Neve: Joe D'Agostino received a report from Rich Neve who was unable to attend tonight's board meeting. The report spoke about the effect future developments in the neighborhood will continue to affect Fiesta Gardens Homes Association.

**Social** - Pascale Stemmle:

- Easter Egg Hunt: Is scheduled for Saturday, April 15, 2017.
- Volunteers will be needed to help fill the eggs on Thursday, April 13, 2017.
- Volunteers are needed to wear Easter Bunny Costume and take photographs.

#### Parks - Roland Bardony:

- Graffiti was found at playground in four different places. Roland Bardony removed the graffiti.
- Roland received a report that the sidewalk in front of the childrens park had lifted and become a trip hazard. He reported it to the City of San Mateo and the sidewalk was repaired.
- Park trees need to be sprayed for aphids.
- Roland would like to purchase one tree from Scapes Landscaping. On a motion duly made and seconded and approved by all board members present the amount not to exceed \$275.00 plus labor costs from Scapes.

**Pool Maintenance** - Mike Russell: Reported that the pool motor is not working. The replacement part will cost approximately \$1,000.

Pool Operations - Steve Stanovcak: was not present.

#### Old Business:

- Joe D'Agostino-President reported that the New Clubhouse documents were sent to the City of San Mateo and now have a permit number. The City of San Mateo may request a few updates to the plans, but nothing major. Joe would like to obtain bids on the project to get an idea of cost to build, then determine if the association currently has enough money for the project. If not, there may be a special assessment needed. Goal is to begin the project when this pool season ends.
- Governing Documents: Joe D'Agostino-President reported that the new Bylaws passed and the new CC&Rs received over ½ of the membership approval. At least a 2/3rds vote approval is needed to pass. The Board is working with an attorney. There will be an open court hearing next month. Notices will go out to all members and they are welcome to attend the hearing.

• The Board discussed changing the day of the week that Board Meetings are held to the first Wednesday of each month. On a motion duly made and seconded and approved by all board members present, the new meeting date was approved.

It was noted that the next Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 3, 2017 at 7:00pm. There being no further business before the Board, the Meeting was adjourned at 8:22pm.
