

ORDINANCE NO 769.

An ordinance establishing and maintaining a sidewalk.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. That a sidewalk five feet (5 ft) wide be constructed and maintained on and along the west side of block seventy-five (75) in the city of Garnett, Kansas; and on and along the west side of block one (1) and block ten (10) in Chapman's Addition to the city of Garnett, Kansas,

Section 2. That said sidewalk be built and maintained of material provided in Ordinance Number 320, except that portion of block seventy-five where the Mo.P. tracks cross said block, which may be built of heavy planks or timbers, and said sidewalk shall be built within thirty days from the passage of this ordinance, and if not so built the street commissioner shall build the same, and the cost shall be certified to the County Clerk, to be placed on the tax roll as the law provides.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after ten (10) days from the passage of this ordinance and its publication in the Garnett Review, the official paper of the said City.
