

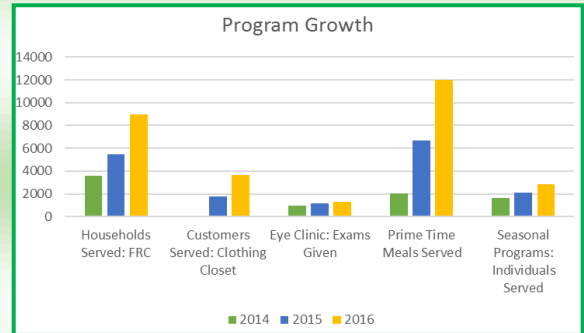

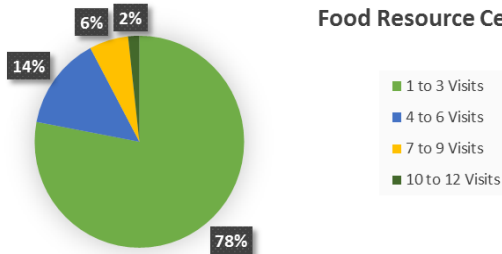
The mission of Skyline Urban Ministry is to impact lives, to empower those in need,

Skyline Programs Are Growing

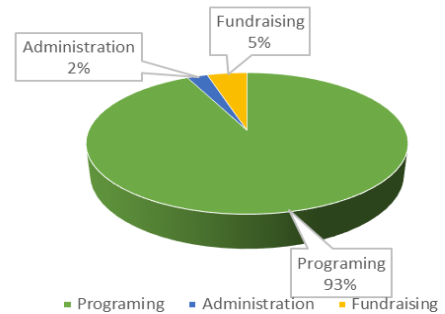
Looking at the chart to the right, we can see the increasing needs met by Skyline over the past three years. Each program has increased the services extended to those living in the shadows. Skyline is located in an area filled with hungry folks, and, thanks to donors like you, we have been able to fill the gaps. As can be seen in the chart below, the vast majority of households need Skyline's assistance only 1-3 times per year.



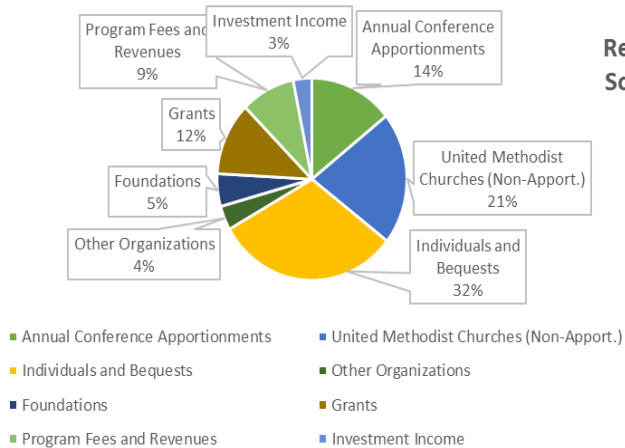
2016 Household Usage of the Food Resource Center

Skyline receives donations from a variety of sources: The Oklahoma Conference of the United Methodist Church combined with above and beyond giving from UM churches provides about one-third of Skyline's annual income. Another one-third is provided through devoted individuals who see the need and step-up to meet it. Skyline uses those generous gifts with the utmost diligence and stewardship: \$0.93 of every dollar received goes directly to providing the services needed by those living in the shadows of the Oklahoma City skyline.
