

ORDINANCE 2008 11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE
RELATING TO THE MARSHAL SERVICE

WHEREAS the Town is under continuing financial strain, and:

WHEREAS experience with the current number of deputies indicates that savings can be accomplished by reducing the number of full time paid deputies and utilizing a mix of part time officers and reserve officers.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

As of the 17th day of June, 2008.

- A. The total number of full time authorized deputy marshals shall be 2.
- B. INTENTIONALLY BLANK The total number of part time paid deputy marshals shall be not more than INTENTIONALLY BLANK whose weekly paid hours will not be more than INTENTIONALLY BLANK per week. The rate of pay will be based on the pay of a regular patrolman's pay based on a 40 hour week.
- C. The total number of unpaid reserve officers shall not be more than 10.

All other provisions of the exiting ordinance remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance is hereby passed and adopted at the meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, this 17th day of June, 2008.
