**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TIME LIMIT FOR CITIZENS TO BE HEARD
DURING COMMISSION MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, the City of Garnett, Kansas, provides for and schedules a period of time on each meeting's agenda for citizens of Garnett to address the commission; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to balance the need for citizens to be heard at regular meetings with allowing adequate time on the meeting's agenda to handle other scheduled business without delay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARNETT, KANSAS, that the citizens appearing at a commission meeting and desiring to address the commission under the "Citizens to be Heard" portion of the meeting's agenda shall be limited to five (5) minutes to be heard at that meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission may extend such period of time allowed for any such presentation if the Commission finds that such extension will clarify the citizen's position with further necessary and relevant information, which is not repetitive and which is on-topic, and which will not unreasonably delay action on other agenda items.
