- 6. No refunds will be given once the bowler rolls the first practice ball of the squad.
- 7. Bowlers will use their highest 2022-2023 certified league average as of January 1, 2023.
- 8. Averages must be for 9 or more games. This includes certified high school competition.
- 9. Bowlers/coaches must supply record or standing sheets to verify bowler averages.
- 10. Bowlers without verifiable averages will bowl scratch.
- 11. Handicap will be 90% of the difference of the bowler's average and 220, as described above.
- 12. Bowlers will be allowed a minimum of 5 minutes of practice on their starting pair.
- 13. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled.
- 14. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero.
- 15. Frames may not be made up.
- 16. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will receive a 0 for that frame.
- 17. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the settee area.
- 18. Ties will not be broken. Additional awards and/or scholarships may be presented.
- 19.
