Camp H.E.A.R. is a one of its kind retreat designed specifically for children with hearing loss and their families. The entire family is invited to attend and spend the weekend at one of our amazing partner camps. Our original **Camp H.E.A.R.: Long View Ranch** located in Mosheim TN, sits along the winding Nolichucky River, with beautiful views of the Great Smoky Mountains. **Camp H.E.A.R. : Rockbridge** located in Goshen, VA is nestled in the beautiful Appalachian Mountains of Virginia. Best of all the entire weekend is offered at **NO COST** thanks to our donors, sponsors, and the hard work of the Waiting to Hear fundraising team.

Children will get to participate in traditional summer camp activities, as well as a few special surprises along the way.
