Gone are the days when one used to use Islam to gain power

Prime Minister Imran Khan, while addressing a public rally in Gilgit-Baltistan, told the 'Azadi March' protesters congregated in Islamabad that when they run out of food, more will be sent to them, but their leaders should not expect any amnesty from him.

"Gone are the days when one used to use Islam to gain power. This is a new Pakistan. Sit however long you want. When your food runs out, we will send more. But we will not give you an NRO," declared the prime minister.

His comments came shortly before PML-N President Shehbaz Sharif joined the Azadi March in Islamabad.

Visiting the region on the occasion of its independence day, the prime minister regretted that while the day marked a glorious event, a movement was on that day seeking disruption in Islamabad.

"We are celebrating your independence while an Azadi March [is ongoing in Islamabad]. Who are they wishing to gain freedom from?"

"I want the media to go there and ask people who they wish to free themselves from," said the prime minister, stating that all his opponents appear disjointed in their thoughts and aims.

"If you ask PPP, they will talk about inflation; if you talk to PML-N they won't know why they are there. JUI-F will decry a 'Jewish conspiracy' [to undermine Pakistan]."

"When Maulana Fazlur Rehman is there [in Islamabad] we have no need of foreign conspiracies," said the premier, adding: "The way the Indian media is celebrating [this march], it makes it seem he [Rehman] himself is (an Indian) national."

The prime minister regretted the use of Islam for shoring up votes. "The youth will be misled. They will think he [the Maulana] is the caretaker of Islam. Instead of coming to Islam, people will leave religion after looking at him."

"People are on to you now, Fazl. This is the age of social media. People know there is no substance in your statements. People still remember what the PPP and PML-N



had said when PTI gave a dharna [in 2014]," he said. "Even Asfandyar [Wali] is there, who used to speak against JUI-F all the time," remarked the prime minister. The prime minister also asked what Bilawal Bhutto-Zardari, the PPP leader who usually takes progressive political positions, is doing joining hands with a right-wing Islamist party.

"Bilawal, who calls himself a liberal, has also joined the jalsa. [It seems] the only thing 'liberal' about Bilawal is that he is liberally corrupt," he said.

He asked all parties who had gathered in Islamabad to tell people what their real motive is. "Tell people why you have really gathered," he dared the opposition.

He said the real reason is that their corruption cases are "laid bare for everyone to see. They are all afraid they will be next."

The prime minister vowed to turn a new page in the history of the country. "We will not be a country which allows such thieves to live in palaces. You will [all] go to jail. And then people will be afraid to do [what you have done]."



India-Saudi Arabia Ties Scaling New Heights



A harbinger of the growing closeness between New Delhi and Riyadh is the number of high-level visits by political leaders from both countries in recent years. For the second time, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi is travelling to Saudi Arabia to attend the Future Investment Summit to be held in Riyadh on October 29-31. The frequency of such visits clearly manifests the strategic importance accorded by both countries to one another. It is expected, during Modi's visit, that both sides will sign energy deals, including the promise of Saudi participation in India's strategic petroleum reserve. Further, details about the planned Indo-Saudi Strategic Partnership Council are likely to be discussed.

Today's Indo-Saudi cooperation is no longer restricted to the traditional sphere of oil-energy trade. Instead, the relationship has become multifaceted thanks to the impetus given by the leaderships of both countries to other areas, including defense, maritime security, counterterrorism, science and technology, strategic oil reserves, investments, tourism, and so on. This bonhomie has come about at a time when mega economic reform programs are underway in Saudi Arabia, for which it welcomes India's economic as well as technological assistance. Likewise, New Delhi looks for Saudi investments in India's petrochemicals, infrastructure, and mining sectors alongside cooperation in economic and security matters.

That transformation was brought about by strong political will in both India and Saudi Arabia to take relations to new heights. The current scenario is unlike the Cold War period when India-Saudi Arabia ties were mainly determined by the Pakistani factor. For decades, this prevented both New Delhi and Riyadh from discovering the strategic importance of engaging one another. But, over a period, they have begun to disentangle themselves from certain inhibitions of the past. Lately, there have been indications that Saudi Arabia is less interested in meddling in India's internal affairs. This could be a reason why the Saudi government, during National Security Advisor



There are better 'sourcing countries' than China

Columbia Sportswear beat sales and profit estimates in its third-quarter report and raised its earnings guidance for the current quarter, but shares failed to rally in the session.

The stock was weighed down by doubts that Chinese officials reportedly have about the prospects of reaching a trade deal with U.S. negotiators. Longtime CEO Tim Boyle on Thursday told CNBC's Jim Cramer that the apparel company has been shifting sourcing away from China.

"We've, over the last several years, been moving product out of China, not because we don't like China, but frankly because there's been better opportunities in other sourcing countries," he said in a "Mad Money" interview.

Boyle did not elaborate on the better sourcing countries, though the company includes Vietnam among its top sites.

The stock price dropped more than 3% to \$90.45 per share during the trading day, the same day that Bloomberg News reported that Chinese officials worried about the chances of striking a long-term U.S.-China trade deal because of President Donald Trump's "impulsive nature," which contributed to the stock market's negative trading day.

Columbia, whose brands include Mountain Hardwear, Sorel and OutDry among others, makes accessories and equipment in more than a dozen countries. More than 60% of its products, particularly footwear, in 2018 were manufac-

ured in Vietnam and China.

Management has warned in the past that tariffs on Chinese imports would force the company to raise prices on affected merchandise if they were to go into effect. Beyond manufacturing, Columbia also sells a lot of products in China, where the firm has been doing business for almost two decades, Boyle said.

Sorel, a subsidiary that makes and distributes shoes and boots, brought in \$116 million of sales versus the \$103.7 million that Wall Street estimated in the quarter. However, Columbia is unable to move the "highly technical" production out of China fast enough, Boyle said.

Sorel's sales did improve by 27% from the year-ago quarter, which beat out the nearly 14% growth in the Columbia brand, according to FactSet.

"We're paying additional tariffs on that merchandise, which we've been very clear it's bad for consumers globally, bad specifically for consumers in the United States," Boyle said. "We're free traders. We like the opportunity to sell more merchandise at better prices to consumers."

Columbia shares are up 7.56% year to date. That's down from the nearly 28% gains the equity made through late July, FactSet said.

A 63-year-old Chinese fugitive was found by a police drone after living in a remote hillside cave for 17 years

Chinese police caught a 63-year-old Chinese fugitive after drone footage located his makeshift hideaway embedded inside a remote hillside cave.

Song Moujiang escaped from prison in March 2002 and had evaded police capture for 17 years, police in Yongshan county said. Song had been jailed for trafficking women and children.

Police discovered his makeshift shelter in the mountains behind his hometown after their drone identified a blue colored steel tile amid the dense bush.

The man lived in the cave residence — which was less than 21 square feet — for so long that his communication skills were hindered, police said.

A man who escaped prison and remained a fugitive for 17 years was caught by Chi-

nese police last week after drone footage revealed his makeshift hideaway embedded inside a remote hillside cave.

Police in Yongshan, a county in China's southwestern Yunnan province, revealed details of the discovery and photos of the man on WeChat last week.

The fugitive, 63-year-old Song Moujiang escaped a prison camp in the nearby Sichuan province in March 2002 and has been on the run ever since. He had been jailed for trafficking women and children. Police did not mention when Song was imprisoned.

The force said it had received a tip that Song was possibly hiding in the mountains behind his hometown of Yongshan County, though they had trouble searching for his location due to steep slopes and

rocky terrain.

So police decided to employ the use of a drone in order to conduct their search, they said. Yongshan Police/WeChat

Police located Song's hideout on the morning of September 19 after drone footage identified a blue steel tile amid the dense bush. After more than an hour of hiking, police say they found Song's shelter, which was located in a cave on the cliff.

Police arrested the man inside, who confessed to escaping the prison camp and evading their capture for 17 years.

The man lived in the cave residence — which was less than two square meters or 21 square feet — for so long that his communication skills had become hindered,



police said.

"He expressed himself poorly and there were slight barriers to his communication," police said. During his stay in the cave Song used plastic bottles to get water from a nearby ravine, the BBC reported, citing state media.

He has now been sent back to jail, the BBC reported. Yahoo News

Vietnam Seizes \$4.3B in Falsely Labeled Chinese Aluminum

Vietnamese customs discovered and seized about \$4.3 billion of Chinese aluminum falsely labeled "Made-in-Vietnam" before being shipped mostly to the U.S., the Dan Tri news website reported, citing Nguyen Van Can, head of the General Department of Vietnam Customs.

The aluminum was imported from China by a company based in the southern province of Ba Ria-Vung Tau that tried to sidestep U.S. tariffs, according to the re-

port that didn't give the company's name. Vietnamese customs worked with American authorities during the investigation.

Vietnam has become a top destination for suppliers looking to avoid U.S. and Chinese tariffs amid the ongoing trade war between the great powers, which also makes it a potential magnet for fraudsters.

Vietnamese authorities are increasing scrutiny on product origins and tightening issuance of certificate of origins for exports, in an attempt to stop trade fraud, Deputy Minister of Trade and Industry Tran Quoc Khanh told reporters in Hanoi

in July. The government has stepped up its efforts "to prevent the Vietnamese territory from being taken advantage of, and not being used to avoid tariff with any markets," Khanh said.

Vietnamese shipments to the U.S. increased 26.6% from January through October compared to the same period last year, the Hanoi-based General Statistics Office said in an estimate released earlier today.

Saudi Prince Tells U.S. Congress to Get Over Its Frustrations

(Bloomberg) -- Prince Turki Al-Faisal, a former Saudi intelligence chief and an influential royal family member, told U.S. lawmakers to get off their "high moralistic horses" as ties between the historical allies remain frayed a year after the murder of columnist Jamal Khashoggi.

Prince Turki criticized congressional representatives on Wednesday for the "horror" and "disdain" they express for Saudi Arabia, saying U.S. lawmakers are unable to perform their jobs to address "issues of racism and racial inequality" and to reform gun ownership laws. He also said that most U.S. media has a "consistently blinkered view" of Saudi Arabia, one that portrays negative events in the kingdom as "being the norm."

The murder last year of Khashoggi, a U.S. resident and Washington Post columnist, as well as the long-running war and humanitarian crisis in Yemen and the

detention of Saudi female activists have all strained the kingdom's relations with much of the Washington establishment outside the White House. Senior lawmakers in both parties remain unified on the issue of punishing the kingdom.

Prince Turki spoke at an event in Washington about a week before Saudi Arabia hosts its annual investment forum, the Future Investment Initiative. The Oct. 29-31 event is set to attract some of Wall Street's top dealmakers, as well as representatives from major institutional investors across the globe, after many skipped the forum last year.

Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin and Jared Kushner, a White House adviser and President Donald Trump's son-in-law, plan to attend the investment event. Mnuchin last year boycotted the investment meeting after Khashoggi was killed and dismembered by Saudi agents in Turkey.

How many congressional leaders "have deigned to pay a visit to the kingdom?" Prince Turki said at the event. "Should they visit Riyadh they may learn something about universal health care, which the kingdom has provided for its citizens since its establishment" or "they may get an insight into our improving and evolving educational system."

Saudi Arabia has been working hard to remake its image since the Khashoggi killing, marketing it as a tourist destination. It is building major tourism projects, transforming its Red Sea coastline to bring in holidaymakers and developing an entertainment city near the capital of Riyadh. The kingdom also said it plans to drop a requirement for men and women who visit to prove they're related in order to share a hotel room.

Last month, Saudi Arabia announced it

would drop its strict dress code for foreign women, who will no longer be required to wear an abaya, the flowing cloak that's been mandatory attire for decades. "Modest clothing" will still be called upon, according to Ahmed Al-Khateeb, chairman of the Saudi Commission for Tourism and National Heritage.

Changes introduced by Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman were praised on Thursday by Timothy Lenderking, the deputy assistant secretary for Arabian Gulf Affairs.

Prince Mohammed is leading "very dynamic change" inside Saudi Arabia, Lenderking said at the same event as Prince Turki on Thursday. "The change is real, it's beneficial. The Saudi population, by and large, is responding very positively to it"

Man, 58, who was arrested after family was held in secret room for nine years 'is not their father'

A man who was arrested after a Dutch family was discovered inside a hidden room is not their dad, according to a local mayor.

Josef B, 58, from Austria, was detained by police officers after it was reported seven people had been living inside a small room in Drenthe in the Netherlands for nine years, according to the Telegraaf.

A man, 58, and six young adults aged between 18 and 25 were said to have been living there.

They were only discovered when the eldest of the children ordered a beer at a bar in the nearby village of Ruinerwold before telling staff he needed help.

Josef B was described as a handyman and

woodworker who ran a workshop in Mepel, which is located 6km from Drenthe. Police said the older man had been arrested after refusing to co-operate.

They added that they had yet to determine whether the young adults were living in the room, which was situated at the bottom of a staircase hidden behind a cupboard, voluntarily.

The force wrote in a tweet: "Yesterday someone reported to us [that they were] worried about the living conditions of people in a house in Buitenhuizerweg in #Ruinerwold.

"We still have many unanswered questions."

Did American-Built Patriot Missiles Fail to Protect Saudi Arabia?

Key point: Patriot batteries are supposed to be state-of-the-art when it comes to air and missile defense.

The missile strikes that badly damaged a key Saudi oil facility on Sept. 14, 2019 largely remain a mystery to the public.

Yemen's Houthi rebels, who have been at war with a Saudi-Emirati coalition since 2015, claimed responsibility for the coordinated attacks on two Saudi Aramco facilities, but it's unclear that the Houthis alone possess the capacity for long-range, precision-guided strikes.

It's possible the attacks involved far-flying drones firing small, guided munitions. The Aramco sites are around 800 miles from the Saudi Arabia-Yemen border. Iran's hard-line Revolutionary Guard Corps in the past has supplied the Houthis with weaponry including drones and components for ballistic missiles.

But one thing is clear. The attack revealed the limits of Saudi Arabia's seemingly sophisticated air-defense system. Riyadh in recent years has spent billions of dollars building up six battalions of U.S.-made Patriot surface-to-air missiles and associated radars. The Patriots didn't stop the recent attack.

And it wasn't the first time Saudi Arabia's Patriots have failed. At least five Patriots apparently missed, malfunctioned or otherwise failed when Saudi forces tried to intercept a barrage of rockets targeting Riyadh on March 25, 2018.

Houthi forces fired at least seven rockets at Saudi Arabia that night. The Saudi military launched Patriot Advanced Capability-2 missiles in an attempt to destroy the Houthi rockets in mid-air. The Saudis claimed seven of the Patriots struck their targets.

Indian Congress party official sounds alarm on party's fate

NEW DELHI (AP) — A senior leader of India's main opposition Congress party says its struggles are at the point that it may not be able to win key upcoming state elections or ensure its own future.

The party is facing attrition because it is taking too long to come to terms with its defeat in May national elections, former External Affairs Minister Salman Khurshid told reporters late Monday.

Congress won only 52 of 542 parliamentary seats in the polls, compared to 303 won by Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party.

The party faces crucial tests in Oct. 21 state elections in Haryana in the north and Maharashtra in the west.

Party president Rahul Gandhi resigned after the May defeat. His mother, Sonia Gandhi, stepped in on an interim basis. The party's chief in Haryana quit following a difference with the party's leadership over a choice of candidates. Ashok Tanwar was among the party's main campaigners

in the party's bid to wrest power from the Bharatiya Janata Party in the state.

A revolt also is brewing in Maharashtra. Sanjay Nirupam, a key state leader there, threatened to quit the party after his recommendations for its nominees were rejected by the party leadership.

An Uttar Pradesh state lawmaker, Aditi Singh, also seemed to join the revolt by staying away from a street march held by Priyanka Gandhi, a party general secretary and daughter of Sonia Gandhi, in the family's stronghold of Rae Bareilly in Uttar Pradesh.

A top party leader and former finance minister, P. Chidambaram, has been arrested by federal investigators for alleged economic offenses, adding to the party's woes.


On Monday, Khurshid said Rahul Gandhi left in a huff after the party's defeat in national elections, and that his mother was appointed interim president in August until a new president is chosen by the

party, possibly after the October state elections.

"We haven't really got together to analyze why we got defeated. Our biggest problem is our leader has walked away," Khurshid said, adding that Rahul Gandhi still retains the allegiance of the party.

"It's kind of left a vacuum," Khurshid said. "Sonia Gandhi stepped in, but there is more than an indication that she is treating herself as a stop-gap arrangement. I wish it wasn't so."

Rahul Gandhi's family, starting with his great-grandfather, Jawaharlal Nehru, has produced three prime ministers. Two of them — his grandmother Indira Gandhi and his father, Rajiv Gandhi — were assassinated in office. Rahul Gandhi lost his own seat, long a Congress party bastion, in Uttar Pradesh in the recent elections. However, he won a seat from another constituency in southern India.

Hong Kong's protesters shouldn't count on American virtue-signallers to solve their deadlock with Beijing

The decision by the US House of Representatives to pass legislation tightening up the scrutiny of Hong Kong's autonomy from mainland China could mark a significant inflection point in the continuing impasse between protestors there and Beijing.

The Hong Kong Human Rights and Democracy Act of 2019, which passed through Congress on 15 October, was first introduced in June. Under the law, the US State Department would be required to certify each year whether Hong Kong warrants its unique treatment by the US under various treaties. It also proposes to restrict access to the US to any deemed responsible for human rights violations in the province.

The bill looks set to obtain approval by the Senate quite swiftly and could be signed off by President Donald Trump as early as next week.

In the long run though, what is clear from 60 years of research into conflict resolution, is that only the protagonists – in this case in Hong Kong and Beijing – can ever achieve a satisfactory resolution to their differences, as they alone have an immediate and enduring stake there.

Outsiders may facilitate dialogue, or even cajole the various parties involved, through diplomatic, as well as economic and occasionally military means, but they invariably have quite different interests to those who must live with the situation on the ground. This is particularly true of diaspora communities – in this instance in Canada and Australia in particular – who are often more disconnected and disgruntled.

The attention span of external agents is limited too, as they invariably turn to more pressing concerns of their own. And, as the media circus moves on from Hong Kong, as has been seen again and again in recent years – across Somalia, Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya, Syria and elsewhere – so

those keen to advertise and promote their caring credentials appear to forget, or even ignore, any ensuing confusions their policies and actions may leave behind.

The scale of protests now happening in Hong Kong have not been driven solely by the proposed introduction of a new Extradition Bill to the mainland. Nor are they merely about the competence and legitimacy (or otherwise) of the incumbent chief executive Carrie Lam.

As with the on-going outbreak of unrest in Chile – superficially ignited through the introduction of new metro fares – or the outbreak of looting in many urban centres across the UK in 2011 – the real drivers invariably reach deeper than the specific sparks that serve as catalysts.

What ought to concern Beijing most is the breadth and depth of popular disconnection these events represent. Five years ago, when facing the so-called Umbrella Movement protests that paralysed the city centre and railed against the selection process for the future leadership of the province, the authorities were able to simply sit it out. Those involved failed to develop their agenda or build any broader base of support.

Earlier protests in Hong Kong after the handover from British rule in 1997, were even smaller and more parochial in their outlook. These complained about those driving over from mainland China to obtain infant milk formula (deemed safer in Hong Kong in the aftermath of the melamine tainted milk scandal of 2008), or investing in real estate, as well as coming to give birth to benefit from Hong Kong's special privileges. The images these presented of truculent mainlanders polluting the province were both elitist and unedifying.

The protesters appear to have learnt from those failures. But they still need to ward against the more petty-minded elements

in their midst if they are to sustain their momentum and engage a wider community.

The real challenge for all concerned is that Hong Kong is different to mainland China – not because of its former colonial connection, but because of the spirit of independence that is palpably manifest there. Beijing may not appreciate this, but it shouldn't seek to crush Hong Kong into conformity, as it is this creative energy that China most needs if it is to continue to flourish in the period ahead.

At the same time though, Hong Kong's own future clearly lies in its relationship to the People's Republic by which it is surrounded physically, and through which it is intertwined culturally. As with the special position of Catalans in the richest region of Spain, so too ought the protestors in Hong Kong appreciate how their secessionist tendencies could lead to a lengthy process of attrition with Beijing and economic atrophy as investors begin to look elsewhere.

The intervention of the US Congress superficially appeals to virtue-signallers in the US keen to talk about human rights and democracy. But the real problem with the new bill is that it has played into Beijing's hand by allowing it to complain more legitimately about foreign interference in its sovereign affairs.

While supposedly seeking to uphold the Basic Law of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the bill actually contravenes this by seeking to include a party to the text – the US government – that is not mentioned there. At the same time, protesters in Hong Kong should note that the wording of the new bill is as much about excluding Hong Kong from privileged trading status in the future as about protecting the people there.



The protesters in Hong Kong ought to be particularly wary of looking for outside help to achieve a resolution to their dispute with Beijing. Again, and again in such situations, those who focus externally for solutions, rather than winning their argument and support internally, find themselves caught short where it matters most – at home.

At the same time, it is not so much the malign influence of foreign funds and agitators on the ground that Beijing ought to reflect upon. These may, or may not, be present but – as with those who obsess over Russian influence behind Trump's election victory or blame foreigners for protests in Russia – focusing on such aspects avoids the reality of the millions of ordinary citizens whose voices will need to be engaged with for any resolution to be reached.

In this instance, China could risk becoming the one thing a confused and directionless West has been looking for for some time – a new enemy to cohere itself against.

Gulf dispute unacceptable, must be resolved: Kuwaiti emir

Kuwait City (AFP) - A damaging 30-month-old dispute between Qatar and its Gulf neighbours "is no longer acceptable" and must be resolved, Kuwait's Emir Sheikh Sabah al-Ahmad Al-Sabah said

Addressing the opening session of parliament's new term, Sheikh Sabah said the Saudi-led boycott has greatly weakened the unity of the six-nation Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) in which Qatar and its foes are members.

GCC members Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and Bahrain, in addition to Egypt, imposed a sea, land and air boycott of Qatar in June 2017 accusing it of ties to radical groups. Doha has repeatedly

denied the allegations.

"It is no longer acceptable or bearable for the dispute that erupted between our GCC brethren to continue," Sheikh Sabah, 90, told parliament in his first public appearance since travelling abroad for medical treatment in early September.

Sheikh Sabah, who has been acting as a mediator to resolve the dispute, said the "row has weakened our capabilities and threatened our achievements", calling for a negotiated solution.

The emir called for national unity in the

face of regional developments and protests in several Arab countries.

He also hit out at the misuse of social media, saying it has created divisions in society.



In Kuwait, dozens of online activists have been sentenced to various jail terms, mainly for criticising the emir.



When to worry about worrying

There is no shortage of things to worry about --- from personal concerns about job security or health, to fears related to larger issues such as political conflicts or natural disasters. Temporary anxiety can be a healthy response to uncertainty and danger, but constant worry and nervousness may be a sign of generalized anxiety disorder.

Do I have generalized anxiety disorder? You'll need your doctor's help to know for sure, but while other types of anxiety disorders arise from particular situations, generalized anxiety disorder is characterized by debilitating worry and agitation about nothing in particular, or anything at all.

People with generalized anxiety disorder tend to worry about everyday matters. They can't shake the feeling that something bad will happen and they will not be

prepared. They may worry to excess about missing an appointment, losing a job, or having an accident. Some people even worry about worrying too much.

Physical symptoms are common too, and can include a racing heart, dry mouth, upset stomach, muscle tension, sweating, trembling, and irritability. These bodily expressions of anxiety can have a negative effect on physical health. For example, people with generalized anxiety disorder are at greater risk for heart attack and other cardiovascular problems.

Taming anxiety

If you have generalized anxiety disorder, therapy — particularly cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) — can help. CBT helps people recognize when they are misinterpreting events, exaggerating difficulties, or making unnecessarily pessimistic assump-

tions, and offers new ways to respond to anxiety-provoking situations.

For some people, medications can be an important part of treatment. Commonly prescribed drugs include antidepressants, such as selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (like Prozac or Zoloft), or dual serotonin and norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (like Effexor or Cymbalta). These drugs take longer to work than the traditional anti-anxiety drugs, but also may provide greater symptom relief over time.

When it comes to cholesterol levels, white meat may be no better than red meat — and plant-based protein beats both

A study published recently in the American Journal of Clinical Nutrition sparked interest when it reported that red and white meat have a similar effect on low-density lipoprotein (LDL, or "bad") cholesterol, which is associated with increased heart disease risk. You may conclude, "Well, if chicken is just as bad for my cholesterol as red meat, I may as well order that hamburger."

But let's examine the study more closely before drawing any conclusions.

Red meat, white meat, or non-meat? The study examined whether cholesterol levels differed after consuming diets high in red meat compared with diets with similar amounts of protein from white meat or non-meat sources (legumes, nuts, grains, and soy products). It also studied whether the results were affected by the amount of saturated fat in each of the diets.

One hundred and thirteen healthy men and women, ages 21 to 65, participated in the study. Each study participant was randomly assigned to either a high- or low-saturated fat diet. Then, for four weeks each, and in varying orders, they consumed protein from either red meat, white meat, or non-meat sources.

All of the foods consumed during the study were provided by the researchers

Cut back on sugary drinks like soft drinks

(except for vegetables and fruits, to ensure freshness at the time of consumption). To reduce the chances that other factors that would affect cholesterol levels, participants were asked to maintain their baseline activity level and abstain from alcohol. They were also advised to maintain their weight during the study period, and their calories were adjusted if their weight shifted.

White meat has same effect as red meat on cholesterol levels

The study found that LDL cholesterol was significantly higher after consuming the red meat and white meat diets, compared with the non-meat diet. This result was found regardless of whether the diet was high or low in saturated fat, though the high-saturated fat diets had a larger harmful effect on LDL cholesterol levels than the low-saturated fat diets. High-density lipoprotein (HDL, or "good") cholesterol was unaffected by the protein source.

Though striking, the study has a number of limitations. The size of the study, 113 participants, was small; the duration was short (only 16 weeks); and there was a relatively high participant dropout rate. The study also did not include processed meats such as sausage, cold cuts, or bacon, which are known to be particularly harmful for heart health, or grass-fed beef, which is often touted as a healthier red meat option.

Focus on plant-based protein

An important point that might be getting lost in the red meat versus white meat conversation is the beneficial effects of non-meat protein sources on cholesterol levels. As the study authors state, "The present findings are consistent with ... earlier studies of primarily plant-based, lacto-ovo-vegetarian, or vegan dietary patterns reporting significantly lower total, LDL, and HDL cholesterol concentrations than diets including animal protein."

The 2015–2020 Dietary Guidelines support healthy, plant-forward dietary patterns. Examples of plant-based diets include the Mediterranean diet and vegetarian diets.

This study looked at plant-based protein sources, and plant-based diets can provide all the necessary protein for optimal health. Here's a look at the amount of protein contained in a variety of plant-based foods.

Emperor Akbar

Abu'l-Fath Jalal-ud-din Muhammad Akbar (October 1542– 27 October 1605), popularly known as Akbar the Great, (Akbar-i-azam), and also as Akbar I was the third Mughal emperor, who reigned from 1556 to 1605. Akbar succeeded his father, Humayun, under a regent, Bairam Khan, who helped the young emperor expand and consolidate Mughal domains in India.

Defeated in battles at Chausa and Kannauj in 1539 to 1541 by the forces of Sher Shah Suri, Mughal emperor Humayun fled westward to Sindh. There he met and married the then 14-year-old Hamida Banu Begum, daughter of Shaikh Ali Akbar Jami, a Persian teacher of Humayun's younger brother Hindal Mirza. Jalal-ud-din Muhammad Akbar was born the next year on 15 October 1542 at the Rajput Fortress of Umerkot in Sindh (in modern-day Pakistan), where his parents had been given refuge by the local Hindu ruler Rana Prasad.

Following the chaos over the succession of Sher Shah Suri's son Islam Shah, Humayun reconquered Delhi in 1555, leading an army partly provided by his Persian ally Tahmasp I. A few months later, Humayun died. Akbar's guardian, Bairam Khan concealed the death in order to prepare for Akbar's succession. Akbar succeeded Humayun on 14 February 1556, while in the midst of a war against Sikandar Shah to reclaim the Mughal throne. In Kalanaur, Punjab, the 14-year-old Akbar was enthroned by Bairam Khan on a newly constructed platform, which still stands. He was proclaimed Shahanshah (Persian for "King of Kings").

Bairam Khan ruled on his behalf until he came of age. Akbar's father Humayun had regained control of the Punjab, Delhi, and Agra with Safavid support, but even in these areas Mughal rule was precarious, and when the Surs reconquered Agra and Delhi following the death of Humayun, the fate of the boy emperor seemed uncertain. Bairam Khan was ultimately able to prevail over the nobles, however, and it was decided that the Mughals would march against the strongest of the Sur rulers, Sikandar Shah Suri, in the Punjab. Delhi was left under the regency of Tardi Baig Khan. Sikandar Shah Suri, however, presented no major concern for Akbar, and avoided giving battle as the Mughal army approached. The gravest threat



came from Hemu, a minister and general of one of the Sur rulers, Adil Shah, who had proclaimed himself Hindu emperor and expelled the Mughals from the Indo-Gangetic plains. Urged by Bairam Khan, who re-marshalled the Mughal army before Hemu could consolidate his position, Akbar marched on Delhi to reclaim it. His army, led by Bairam Khan, defeated Hemu and the Sur army on 5 November 1556 at the Second Battle of Panipat, 50 miles (80 km) north of Delhi. Soon after the battle, Mughal forces occupied Delhi and then Agra. Akbar made a triumphant entry into Delhi, where he stayed for a month.

By 1559, the Mughals had launched a drive to the south into Rajputana and Malwa. However, Akbar's disputes with his regent, Bairam Khan, temporarily put an end to the expansion. The young emperor, at the age of eighteen, wanted to take a more active part in managing his affairs. Urged on by his foster mother, Maham Anga, and his relatives, Akbar decided to dispense with the services of Bairam Khan. After yet another dispute at court, Akbar finally dismissed Bairam Khan in the spring of 1560 and ordered him to leave on Hajj to Mecca. Bairam Khan left for Mecca but was assassinated on his way to Mecca, allegedly by an Afghan with a personal vendetta. After asserting his authority, Akbar continued his campaigns against Rajputana, Eastern and Western India, Safavids in Kandahar, Deccan, Gujrat and Baluchistan and further consolidated his empire.

Akbar was a follower of Salim Chishti, a holy man who lived in the region of Sikri near Agra. Subsequently, he celebrated the victories over Chittor and Ranthambore by laying the foundation of a new walled capital, 23 miles (37 km) west of Agra in 1569, which was named Fatehpur ("town of victory") after the conquest of Gujarat in 1573 and subsequently came to be known as Fatehpur Sikri in order to distinguish it from other similarly named towns. However, the city was soon abandoned and the capital was moved to Lahore in 1585. The reason may have been that the water supply in Fatehpur Sikri was insufficient or of poor quality. In 1599, Akbar shifted his capital back to Agra from where he reigned until his death in 1605.

The practice of arranging marriages between Hindu princesses and Muslim kings was known much before Akbar's time, but in most cases these marriages did not lead to any stable relations between the families involved, and the women were lost to their families and did not return after marriage. However, Akbar's policy of matrimonial alliances marked a departure in India from

previous practice in that the marriage itself marked the beginning of a new order of relations, wherein the Hindu Rajputs who married their daughters or sisters to him would be treated on par with his Muslim fathers-in-law and brothers-in-law in all respects except being able to dine and pray with him or take Muslim wives. These Rajputs were made members of his court and their daughters' or sisters' marriage to a Muslim ceased to be a sign of degradation. The political effect of these alliances was significant. The interaction between Hindu and Muslim nobles in the imperial court resulted in exchange of thoughts and blending of the two cultures. Further, newer generations of the Mughal line represented a merger of Mughal and Rajput blood, thereby strengthening ties between the two. As a result, the Rajputs became the strongest allies of the Mughals.


Akbar was deeply interested in religious and philosophical matters. An orthodox Muslim at the outset, he later came to be influenced by Sufi mysticism that was being preached in the country at that time, and moved away from orthodoxy, appointing to his court several talented people with liberal ideas, including Abul Fazl, Faizi and Birbal. In 1575, he built a hall called the Ibadat Khana ("House of Worship") at Fatehpur Sikri, to which he invited theologians, mystics and selected courtiers renowned for their intellectual achievements and discussed matters of spirituality with them. These discussions, initially restricted to Muslims, were acrimonious and resulted in the participants shouting at and abusing each other. Upset by this, Akbar opened the Ibadat Khana to people of all religions as well as atheists, resulting in the scope of the discussions broadening and extending even into areas such as the validity of the Quran and the nature of God. This shocked the orthodox theologians, who sought to discredit Akbar by circulating rumours of his desire to forsake Islam. However, his interaction with various religious theologians had convinced him that despite their differences, all religions had several good practices, which he sought to combine into a new religious movement known as Din-i-Ilahi. This new religion was never accepted by a majority of the Muslims and after Akbar passed away, Din-i-Ilahi also faded away into the dustbin of history.

Akbar practised several Hindu customs. He celebrated Diwali, allowed Brahman priests to tie jewelled strings round his wrists by way of blessing, and, following his lead, many of the nobles took to wearing rakhi (protection charms). He renounced beef and forbade the sale of all meats on certain days.

In 1562, he married the daughter of Raja Bharmal, ruler of Amer. The marriage took place when Akbar was on his way back from Ajmer after offering prayers to the tomb of Moinuddin Chishti. Bharmal had conveyed to Akbar that he was being harassed by his brother-in-law Sharif-uddin Mirza (the Mughal hakim of Mewat). Akbar insisted that Bharmal should submit to him personally, it was also suggested that his daughter, Jodha Bai, should be married to him as a sign of complete submission. She was entitled Mariam-uz-Zamani after giving birth to Akbar's eldest surviving son, Prince Salim (the future emperor Jahangir). She died on 19 May 1623.

On 3 October 1605, Akbar fell ill with an attack of dysentery from which he never recovered. He is believed to have died on 27 October 1605, after which his body was buried at his mausoleum in Sikandra, Agra.

Akbar left a rich legacy both for the Mughal Empire as well as the Indian subcontinent in general. He firmly entrenched the authority of the Mughal Empire in India and beyond, after it had been threatened by the Afghans during his father's reign, establishing its military and diplomatic superiority. During his reign, the nature of the state changed to a secular and liberal one, with emphasis on cultural integration.

Thai king strips 'disloyal' royal consort of all titles: palace

Bangkok (AFP) - Thailand's King Maha Vajiralongkorn has stripped his 34-year-old consort of all titles for "disloyalty" and apparent "ambition" to match the Queen's position, a royal command issued late Monday said, less than three months after she was bestowed with the honour.

Former royal bodyguard Sineenat Wongvajirapakdi -- known by her nickname "Koi" -- was gifted the title on the king's 67th birthday on July 28, the first time in nearly a century a Thai monarch has taken a consort.

A few days later the palace released images of the short-haired Sineenat in combat fatigues shooting weapons, flying a jet and preparing to parachute from a plane, as well as holding the king's hand.

It was an intimate and rare glimpse into the private life of Thailand's powerful, ultra-wealthy and inscrutable monarch, known as Rama X of the Chakri dynasty.

But on Monday Sineenat's swift and public downfall was relayed on national television.

She was dismissed from the rank of Chao Khun Phra -- or noble consort -- for "disloyalty to the king" according to the command, as well as "acting against the appointment of the Queen (Suthida)... for her own ambitions".

Suthida - the former deputy head of the royal bodyguard - was made Queen in May, becoming King Vajiralongkorn's fourth wife.

The Thai monarchy is protected by a harsh

defamation law, making open discussion on the institution for the public and media based inside the country all but impossible.

Rama X has asserted his authority since his 2016 ascension to the throne, putting the large wealth of the crown under his direct control and restructuring key army units to his command.

Koi, a qualified pilot and former army nurse, was the first woman to receive the consort title in nearly a century -- fitting a pattern of assertive moves by the king.

- Stripped of all ranks -

Her actions show "she does not give any honour to the king and does not understand royal tradition... her actions are to benefit herself", the statement said, adding she was attempting to elevate her position to the same as Queen Suthida.

Her behaviour is "deemed disrespectful to His Majesty's grace... and caused divisions among courtiers and misunderstanding among the people", the statement added.

She was stripped of all military ranks, decorations and royal titles, it said.

Born in the northern province of Nan on January 26, 1985, Sineenat, graduated from the Royal Thai Army Nursing College at the age of 23.



She has also trained as a pilot in Thailand and abroad, served in the King's royal bodyguard unit, and in May was awarded the rank of a major-general.

During the elaborate three-day coronation ceremony of the king in May, Sineenat was seen marching in full military uniform in a procession that travelled from the palace to several Buddhist temples.

Her prominence stunned the Thai public, who often glean clues of the royal family's secretive ongoing through imagery and symbolism relayed by the palace.

Her dramatic fall from grace is likely to be as carefully dissected over coming days.

"The abrupt move by the king tells us that he wishes to be seen as a very in-charge monarch who will not put up with possible divisions in the royal institution," said analyst Paul Chambers of Naresuan University.

Buttressed by the conservative arch royalist military, which has carried out a dozen coups since the 1932 establishment of a



constitutional monarchy, frank discussion of palace affairs is rare among the Thai public.

Rama X came to power in 2016 after the death of his father Bhumibol Adulyadej -- who is widely revered by Thais and seen as a figure of moral authority.

The new king, a cycling and aviation enthusiast, is a more remote figure to the public, having spent much of his time abroad, particularly in Germany.

His three-day coronation gave many Thais their first full glimpse of the new monarch, as he was carried on a palanquin in full regalia around Bangkok's historic quarter.

From monk to billionaire: I-T raids find Rs 500 crore unaccounted money from Kalki Bhagwan's ashrams

The Income-Tax (I-T) department which conducted simultaneous raids on the properties of self-styled godman Kalki Bhagwan in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu has found unaccounted Rs 500 crore from his ashrams.

The income tax department, in a statement, said, "On October 16, the income tax department conducted search action under the Income-Tax act 1961 in the case of conglomerates of trusts and companies run year-round 'wellness courses' and training programmes in philosophy, spirituality, etc., at various sprawling residential campuses."

"The courses attract residential customers from abroad and the group earns substantial receipts in foreign exchange. There was intelligence that the group had been suppressing its receipts, which are ploughed into investment in huge tracts of landed property in Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu and in investments abroad," it stated.

The I-T further said that the search proceedings revealed considerable evidence on various centres of the ashram regularly suppressing its receipts and of key employees who maintained records of collecting cash that was kept outside the accounts.


Apart from these irregularities, the I-T department found US currency of about \$2.5 million dollars (approximately Rs 18 crore). "About 88 kg of undeclared gold jewellery, valued at Rs 26 crore, diamonds amount to 1,271 carats worth about Rs 5 crore, has also been seized. The undisclosed income of the group detected so far is estimated at more than Rs 500 crore," the I-T statement read. Seventy-year-old Vijay Kumar is a self-styled godman who claimed himself to be the 10th avatar of Vishnu-Kalki in the early 1990s.

The institution - Jeevashram - was started in the mid-1980s by Vijay Kumar, who was a former clerk in Life Insurance

Corporation, to provide an "alternative education system to his disciples".

Along the same time, Vijay Kumar also started his Oneness University. The trust of the ashram is run by Vijay Kumar, his wife Padmavati, and son NKV Krishna.

The IT department began the raids on October 16 on over 40 premises in Chennai, Hyderabad, Bengaluru and Varadaihpalem near Chittoor.

European Parliament members to visit disputed Kashmir

NEW DELHI (AP) — Members of the European Parliament met Monday with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi ahead of a visit to disputed Kashmir, where India has imposed a harsh security crackdown.

Modi told the group that their visit “should give them a clear view of the development and governance priorities of the region.”

They are to fly Tuesday to the restive Himalayan region, where restrictions remain in place nearly three months after India imposed the crackdown and stripped Kashmir of its semi-autonomous status.

The Indian government earlier denied access to the region by U.N. special rapporteurs, U.S. congressmen and foreign journalists.

An official in the office of the Delegation of the European Union to India said the visit was unofficial and was being carried out by some members of the European Parliament in their personal capacity.

Reacting to the development, the former chief minister of the region, Mehbooba Mufti, said she hopes the visit indicates that the “iron curtain” imposed by India between Kashmir and the rest of the world is being lifted.

Mufti is among hundreds of pro-India leaders who had been sympathetic to the central government but have been held in makeshift jails or under house arrest since early August, when New Delhi sent tens of thousands of additional troops to the already heavily militarized region, imposed

a sweeping curfew, arrested thousands, and cut virtually all communications.

Authorities have since eased some restrictions, lifting roadblocks and restoring landlines and some mobile phone service. They have encouraged students to return to school and businesses to reopen, but Kashmiris have largely stayed home, in defiance or fear amid threats of violence.

As the crackdown continues, Kashmiris have quietly refused to resume their normal lives, confounding India at their own economic expense.

“Kashmir will keenly watch how freely (the Parliament members) are allowed to move around and meet common people,” said political scientist Noor Ahmed Baba. “The visit will only be worthwhile if the delegation is allowed to meet a cross-section of Kashmiri political opinion.”

The sudden move to allow the delegation’s visit to the Indian-administered region, formally named Jammu and Kashmir, was also questioned by India’s main opposition party, Congress.

“This is an outright insult to India’s own Parliament and our democracy,” senior party leader Jairam Ramesh said.

“When Indian political leaders have been prevented from meeting the people of J&K, what possessed the great chest-beating champion of nationalism to allow European politicians to visit J&K,” he tweeted, referring to Modi.

Many Indian opposition leaders who earlier tried to visit the region were not al-



lowed to do so or were sent back from the Srinagar airport by the authorities.

Kashmir is divided between India and Pakistan but claimed by both. The two countries have fought two wars over control of the region.

India accuses Pakistan of arming and training rebels who have been fighting for Kashmir’s independence or its merger with Pakistan since 1989. Islamabad rejects India’s charge and says it only provides moral and diplomatic support.

About 70,000 people have been killed in the armed uprising and the ensuing Indian military crackdown.

The Modi government says it removed a constitutional provision that gave Kashmir some autonomy so the region could achieve greater economic development by doing away with the sense of separateness that it says cultivated the separatist movement.

Late Monday, a truck driver was shot dead by gunmen in the region’s southern

Anantnag district, police said.

Narayan Dutt, a resident of Katra in Udhampur district, was the fourth truck driver to be killed by gunmen since early August.

Gunmen have targeted apple traders and truck drivers who were about to drive away with the apple consignment from the southern Shopian area in Kashmir.

Officials have blamed militants for the killings.

Kashmir’s apple orchards provide a livelihood for nearly half the region’s 8 million people. Apple growers and traders are suffering losses as insurgent groups put pressure on traders and drivers to shun the industry to protest India’s crackdown.

About 18 people were injured earlier Monday in a grenade attack by militants at a busy market in the northern Sopore area of Kashmir, officials said.

Priyanka Chopra Explains Why She doesn't Take Pressure Anymore

“I like movies that challenge me. I like fiction as well as reality-based. I like the immersive experiences. I like something that will make me nervous coming to set. I


like films where I look at my scene and I am like ‘oh my god! How am I going to do this?’ When your fingers tingle, your toes curl. I like experiences like those,” she said.

Ingredients

For the herb butter:
1 cup unsalted butter , softened
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
6-8 cloves garlic , minced
fresh chopped herbs

Instructions

If the turkey is frozen: Thaw in the fridge,

24 hours for every 5 pounds of Turkey. I like to give myself 1 extra day, just to be safe.

Remove the thawed turkey from the fridge 1 hour before roasting, to let it come to room temperature.

Adjust your oven rack so the turkey will sit in the center of the oven. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F.

Make the herb butter by combining room temperature butter, minced garlic, salt, pepper, one tablespoon fresh chopped rosemary, one tablespoon fresh chopped thyme, and half a tablespoon of fresh chopped sage. (You'll use the remaining fresh herbs for stuffing inside the cavity of the turkey)

Remove turkey from packaging and remove the neck and giblets from the inside the cavities of the bird. (Reserve them for gravy, if you want, or discard them). Pat the turkey very dry with paper towels. Season the cavity of the turkey with salt and pepper. Stuff it with the quartered lemon, onion and apple and leftover herbs. Use your fingers to loosen and lift the skin above the breasts (on the top of the turkey) and smooth a few tablespoons of the herb butter underneath.

Tuck the wings of the turkey underneath the turkey and set the turkey on a roasting

rack inside a roasting pan*.

Microwave the remaining herb butter mixture for 30 seconds (it doesn't need to be completely melted--just really softened). Use a basting brush to brush the remaining herb butter all over the outside of the turkey, legs and wings. Roast at 325 degrees F for about 13-15 minutes per pound, or until internal temperature (inserted on middle of thigh and breast) reaches about 165 degrees.

(I remove the turkey from the oven once it reaches 160 degrees. Then, I tent it with foil, and let it rest on the counter. It will continue cooking under the foil, to reach 165 degrees F.)

***Check the turkey about halfway through cooking, and once the skin gets golden brown, cover the top of the turkey with tinfoil, to protect the breast meat from overcooking. Alternately, you could start cooking the turkey with it tented in foil, then during the last hour or so of cooking you can take the foil off to let the turkey brown.

Allow turkey to rest for 20-30 minutes before carving.

Reserve any drippings and juice remaining in your roasting pan to make turkey gravy.

Notes

*If you don't have a roasting pan, use a



disposable foil roasting pan. Place a bed of chopped veggies —carrots, onion and celery work well— in the bottom of the pan, and set the turkey on top of them.

Pumpkin Pie

An easy recipe for Homemade Pumpkin Pie.

This pumpkin pie recipe is perfect for the holidays!

Course Dessert

INGREDIENTS

Pie Crust:

1 store-bought or homemade pie crust

Pumpkin Pie Filling:

1 cup light brown sugar

1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1 teaspoon ground ginger

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/8 teaspoon ground cloves

3 large eggs lightly beaten

1 15-ounce can pumpkin puree

1 and 1/4 cups evaporated milk

INSTRUCTIONS

To prepare the pie crust:

Preheat oven to 400°F.

Prepare the pie crust by rolling the dough out to 12-inches in diameter. Next, carefully transfer the dough to a 9-inch pie plate (make sure it's at least 1 and 1/2 inches

deep), gently fit it into the pie plate, trim any excess dough, and flute the edges. Line the pie dough with parchment paper or foil, making sure to cover the bottom and fit it snugly in the corners and up the sides, then fill with pie weights (dried beans or dry rice work well too). Bake the pie crust at 400°F for 12-15 minutes. Remove from the oven and remove the parchment paper (or foil) and pie weights. Return the pie crust to the oven and bake for an additional 5 minutes. Remove from the oven and set aside to cool.

To prepare the filling:

In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the brown sugar, flour, salt, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and cloves until well combined. In a separate mixing bowl, whisk together the eggs, pumpkin puree and evaporated milk until well combined. Pour the wet ingredients into the dry ingredients and mix together until fully combined.

To make the pumpkin pie:

Pour the pumpkin pie filling into the partially baked pie crust. Return to the oven and bake at 400°F for 45-50 minutes, or until the center is almost set (it should be a little wobbly). Remove from the oven and transfer to a wire rack for 2-3 hours to cool completely. Cover tightly and refrigerate for several hours or overnight.

NOTES



Cover the edges of the pie crust with a pie crust shield as needed to prevent them from over-browning.

Pie crust may be made 2-3 days in advance, wrap tightly and refrigerate until ready to use. The pumpkin pie filling may also be made up to one day in advance, cover tightly and refrigerate until ready to use.

Prep time does not include cooling time.

Over 55 lakh labours in Delhi to benefit from increased minimum wage: Kejriwal

New Delhi [India], Oct 28 (ANI): Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday said that over 55 lakh labours working on contract in the national capital will continue to avail benefit from the increased minimum wage, which will help them to tackle with the “impact of the economic slowdown” in the country.

“In the last five years, we have taken several decisions for the welfare of the poor. Increasing the minimum wage is one of them. As many as 55 lakh people working on contract in Delhi will be benefitted,” he said in a press conference here.

Kejriwal also said that Delhi has the highest minimum wage in the country.

“The Supreme Court recently approved the minimum wage we had increased. We had approached the top court after Delhi High Court had dismissed the minimum wage notification on a plea filed by a group of 44

traders’ associations challenging the hike,” he explained. The Chief Minister asserted that the Delhi government had to struggle a lot to hike the minimum wage.

“When we came to power, the minimum wage was Rs 8,632 for unskilled labours, which has now been increased to 14,842. The same was Rs 9,542 for semi-skilled labours and is now at Rs 16,341. Skilled labours used to get Rs 10,478 as a minimum wage but they now get Rs 17,991,” Kejriwal said.

He also mentioned that the minimum wage was increased for non-matriculantes, matriculates and graduates from 9,542, 10,478 and 11,414 to 16,341, 17,991 and 19,572 respectively.

Arguing that funds in the lower sections of society trickles down to create larger impacts, he said, “When poor people have

money they go out and buy things, which creates demand, increases production and eventually create jobs.”

“It will help tackle the economic slowdown in the country,” the chief minister said.

He also said that the Delhi government has taken strict actions to ensure the new minimum wage is followed.

“We removed 1,373 contractors working for the government for not paying minimum wage. Cases were also filed against



over 100 persons for incidents pertaining to not paying minimum wages,” Kejriwal added.

Kejriwal also urged the traders to follow the minimum wage notification assuring them that it will benefit everyone in the long run. (ANI)

Pakistan to issue tourist visas to non-Indian Sikhs for Kartarpur visit

Lahore, Oct 28 (PTI) The Pakistan government will issue tourist visas to non-Indian Sikhs visiting the Kartarpur corridor and other ‘gurdwaras’ in the country during the 550th birth anniversary celebrations of Guru Nanak Dev.

Under the Kartarpur Corridor agreement between India and Pakistan, pilgrims coming from India for one day would not require visa but they can only visit Gurudwara Baba Guru Nanak. However, those coming from other countries will need a visa and be free to visit other religious places.

“The Pakistan government will issue tour-

ist visas to (non-Indian) Sikhs coming from Europe, Canada and America for their visit to the Gurdwara Darbar Sahib, Kartarpur Narowal, some 125kms from Lahore,” said a source in the Pakistan Foreign Office.

The official said Indian pilgrims will have to obtain a visa for touring other holy sites in Pakistan.

India and Pakistan signed the historic Kartarpur corridor agreement on October 24.

The Kartarpur corridor will connect the Dera Baba Nanak shrine in India’s Punjab with Darbar Sahib at Kartarpur, just 4

kilometres from the International Border, located at Narowal district of Pakistan’s Punjab province.

While Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Indian side of the corridor on November 8, his Pakistani



counterpart will open the corridor on November 9. PTI MZ INDINDIND

What’s the difference between an MD and a DO, and how do I choose?

The simple answer is that both an MD (Doctor of Medicine) and a DO (Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine) are doctors licensed to practice in the United States. They are similarly educated and certified, but there are differences in their training and philosophy of patient care.

Nine out of 10 practicing doctors in this country are MDs or allopathic physicians, according to the latest data published by the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) in 2012. As the FSMB points out in its Census of Actively Licensed Physicians, however, “the osteopathic medical profession continues to experience exponential growth in its numbers.”

The American Osteopathic Association (AOA) estimates the number of DOs in active medical practice in the United States will surpass 100,000 by next year. According to AOA data, 10 states saw greater than 45 percent growth in the

number of DOs between 2009 and 2014. While your chances of choosing a doctor who’s a DO may be on the rise, most healthcare consumers aren’t sure what osteopathy actually is. The key, according to the AOA, is osteopathy’s “whole person” approach to medicine.

The osteopathic philosophy involves treating the mind, the body, and the spirit. It’s a more holistic approach,” says Michael Jonesco, DO, of Wexner Medical Center at Ohio State University in Columbus. “For the patient, the osteopathic approach is less about prescribing medications and medical procedures and more on the body trying to heal itself.”

RELATED: The Mainstreaming of Osteopathic Medicine

As part of their medical education, DOs receive additional musculoskeletal training known as osteopathic manipulative treatment (OMT). The AOA describes OMT as a hands-on healing method often used to

treat muscle pain that can help patients with conditions such as asthma, sinus disorders, and migraines.

“MDs receive more of the traditional training,” says Kenneth Kaushansky, MD, dean of the Stony Brook University School of Medicine. “The training of an osteopathic physician has a lot more to do with the physical manipulation of the body.”

The American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine (AACOM) represents 30 accredited colleges of osteopathic medicine in the United States.

The Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) and AACOM offer information on how to apply to allopathic or osteopathic medical schools.

Like MDs, DOs can practice in any medical specialty, but a majority choose pri-



mary care specialties. The AOA estimates that 6 out of 10 osteopathic physicians practice family medicine, general internal medicine, pediatrics, or obstetrics and gynecology.

Choosing a doctor, allopathic or osteopathic, is a very personal choice. As Dr. Kaushansky says, “you want to choose someone you feel comfortable with. There are many resources to help you choose, and word of mouth is okay, too. But you need to do your homework.”



Film trade analyst Taran Adarsh took to Twitter to announce the release date of the Mukesh Chhabra directorial.



Statistics show that Trump's "travel ban" was always a Muslim ban

Did President Donald Trump's travel ban—in place now for more than 22 months—become, in practice, a Muslim ban?

The third version of President Donald Trump's travel ban went into full effect on Dec. 8, 2017.

The list of countries whose citizens are banned from entering the United States include Muslim-majority countries Iran, Syria, Libya, Yemen, and Somalia, as well as North Korea and Venezuela.

Now that time has passed, policymakers, political scientists like myself, and all Americans can start to understand the ban's effects.

Was it actually a Muslim ban, as it was called at the time it was introduced? Or was that just an anti-Trump label? What percentage of people from those banned countries did pass the "enhanced vetting" and get an actual visa to enter the United States?

Sharp decline

The US Department of State's Bureau of Consular Affairs regularly provides data on the number of visas issued for all countries.

Based on the data the agency provides for the fiscal year, the number of immigrant visas issued for the country of Iran decreased by 78% between 2017 and 2018.

However, the fiscal year data for the year 2018 included the last three months of 2017, when the travel ban wasn't still implemented. I broke the data down by months to understand how travel ban changed the number of visas issued from calendar year to calendar year. This offered a more accurate picture of the travel ban.

This analysis shows that only 537 immigrant visas were issued in 2018 for the 12 months after the travel ban went into effect for individuals born in Iran. Compare that to 6,643 visas issued in the previous year. That is a 92% decrease in number of

visas issued.

Other Muslim countries in the ban were similarly affected.

For instance, Somalia experienced 86% decrease in number of immigrant visas issued during the 12 months after the travel ban went into effect. Yemen's visas reduced by 83%.

Libya and Syria had the smallest change among the Muslim countries in the ban, decreasing by 80% and 77% respectively.

Muslim vs. non-Muslim countries
Many critics of the new travel rules argued that they were effectively a "Muslim ban."

The Trump administration countered that there are Muslim countries like Saudi Arabia and Afghanistan that are not included in the travel ban, and there are non-Muslim countries like Venezuela and North Korea that are included.

However, US Department of State's Bureau of Consular Affairs data shows that there was a significant decrease in the number of immigrant visas issued to Muslim countries affected by the travel ban. Meanwhile, the number of immigrant visas issued per month to the non-Muslim countries in the ban virtually remained unchanged.

In fact, there was a 40% increase in the number of visas issued to North Koreans per calendar-year data, relative to the prior year, when the travel ban was blocked by federal courts.

Country of chargeability

There are some questions that the government data cannot answer.

For example, rather than providing data on where each visa recipient lives, the US Department of State by report if the Visa Office only offers information on the



country of chargeability, which basically means where the applicant was born.

There were five fiancé visas issued to Iranians in calendar year 2018, compared to 358 fiancé visas issued in 2017. But even that low number does not tell us whether these five visas were given to Iranians that actually lived inside Iran. These visas may have been given to Iranians who had been living in Canada or Europe for many years but were born in Iran.

The actual impact of the Trump travel ban, in other words, could be even bigger than what the data show.

Visas and waivers

Waivers are another important issue that is hard to study.

The vast majority people from the seven restricted countries who applied for a visa after the implementation of the ban were rejected outright.

However, US officials may grant a waiver to someone if there is evidence that the applicant is facing so much undue hardship that they need to be united with their loved ones in the US

This could happen, for example, if a family member in the United States is dying and a person from a restricted nation wants to see them one last time, like the Yemeni mother who got a chance to see her baby boy just two days before he died.

In the first six months after the full imple-

mentation of the ban, such waivers were only given to around 2% of individuals from banned countries. This gradually increased to 6% after one year.

Being considered for a waiver is not the same as getting a visa. A person who is being considered for a waiver still cannot enter the US. They must wait under "administrative processing" status until they are cleared for a visa. It could take several years before applicants find out the results of their application. During this period, they cannot enter the US.

One recent lawsuit against the travel ban claims that some of their 14 clients have been under consideration for a waiver for 18 months at least, with no visa being granted to any of them yet.

What's next

The first congressional hearing on the travel ban, held on Sept. 24, established a need to reassess the impacts of the policy.

From what I see, looking at 18 months of government-provided data, the current travel ban is in effect a Muslim ban.

He was against the triple talaq legislation and resigned because of differences with Rajiv Gandhi on this issue. Arif Mohammed Khan joined the Janata Dal and was re-elected to the Lok Sabha in 1989. During the Janata Dal rule Khan served union Minister of Civil aviation and Energy. He left the Janata Dal to join the Bahujan Samaj Party and again entered the Lok Sabha in 1998 from Bahraich. Khan held ministerial responsibilities from 1984 to 1990. In 2004, he joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and unsuccessfully contested the Lok Sabha election as a BJP candidate that year from Kaisarganj constituency. Khan quit the BJP in 2007 to remain non partisan.

Arif Mohammad Khan was born in 1951 in Bulandshahr, Uttar Pradesh. He was educated at Jamia Millia School, Delhi, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh and Shia College, Lucknow University. Arif Mohammad Khan started his political career as a student leader. He was the President of Aligarh Muslim University Student's Union in the year 1972-73 and also its honorary Secretary a year earlier (1971-72). He contested the first legislative assembly election from Siyana constituency of Bulandshahar on Bharatiya Kranti Dal party's banner but was defeated. He became a member of the legislative assembly of UP in 1977 at the age of 26.

اوج یعقوبی

(حیدرآباد، دکن)

آمدورفت: 1913ء - 1983ء

اوج یعقوبی کی تاریخ پیدائش 10 مارچ 1913ء ہے ان کے والد کا نام سید یعقوب تھا۔ انہوں نے ان کا نام سید عبدالقدیم رکھا تھا۔ تسمیہ خوانی کی رسم میں اخبار روزنامہ ”صحیفہ“ کے مدیر مولانا کبرعلی مرحوم نے اقراء کی تلاوت کروائی تھی۔ انہوں نے مدرسہ تھانویہ چادر گھاٹ، چنچل گوڑہ ہائی اسکول اور گوشہ محل میں تعلیم حاصل کی تھی۔ ادارہ حمیدیہ میں انہوں نے منشی اور فاضل کی تعلیم حاصل کی جس زمانے میں ان کے والد سمٹ بلاک میں سکونت پذیر تھے جو ملک پیٹ ریلوے اسٹیشن کے روبرو تھا۔ اس کے اکناف میں جوش ملیح آبادی، ماہر القادری، خورشید نظیر، پروفیسر عبدالقیوم خاں باقی اور احمد نواز جنگ فانی جیسے باکمال علمی، ادبی اور شاعرانہ ذوق رکھنے والے حضرات رہائش پذیر تھے۔ ان سارے لوگوں کے گھروں میں وہ اپنی کم سنی کی وجہ گھومتے رہتے تھے۔ وہ مہاراجہ کرشن پرشاد شاد کی دیوڑھی میں ہونے والے ماہانہ مشاعروں میں اور ہر ہلائی مہینہ کی 27 کو روزنامہ صحیفہ کی میلا د بلڈنگ میں ہونے والے مشاعروں میں پابندی سے شرکت کیا کرتے تھے۔ اس طرح ان میں ذوق شاعری پروان چڑھتا رہا۔ ابتداء میں وہ اختر تخلص کیا کرتے تھے۔ ان کی شاعرانہ زندگی کا پہلا شعر ملاحظہ فرمائیے:

تری جدائی نے دیوانہ کر دیا مجھ کو

ترے فراق نے شاعر بنا دیا مجھ کو

کچھ عرصہ بعد انہوں نے اشرف تخلص اختیار کیا۔ ان کے بہنوئی سید تاج الہدیٰ جو اپنے دور کے مقبول شاعر تھے انہوں نے ان کو مشورہ دیا کہ تخلص دو حرفی یا زیادہ سے زیادہ سہ حرفی ہونا چاہئے ورنہ اکثر بحر میں زحمت ہوتی ہے۔ انہوں نے ان کے لئے اوج تخلص تجویز کیا۔ اس کے بعد اوج نے اسی تخلص کو اپنا اور اپنے والد کے نام کی نسبت سے یعقوبی کا اضافہ کر لیا۔ اس طرح ادبی دنیا میں وہ اوج یعقوبی کے نام سے مشہور ہوئے۔

صفی اورنگ آبادی کی ڈگر پر چلتے ہوئے انہوں نے شاعری کو ذریعہ آمدنی بنا لیا اور کتنے ہی متشاعروں کو شاعر بنا دیا۔ اوج نے پہلا مشاعرہ روزنامہ صحیفہ کی میلا د بلڈنگ میں پڑھا۔ اس کے بعد وہ اہم شعرا جیسے ضامن کنوری، صفی اورنگ آباد، فصاحت جنگ جلیل، امجد حیدر آبادی، حیرت بدایونی،

سید شہیدی، خورشید احمد جامی اور خواجہ شوق وغیرہ کے ساتھ بیسیوں مشاعرے پڑھے۔ ان کی شاعری میں تجارتی انداز کی تشبیہ کی وجہ سے قابل تلامذہ ان سے کترانے لگے۔ اوج یعقوبی نے تقریباً سارے اصناف سخن مثلاً حمد، نعت، منقبت، مرثیہ، سلام، مثنوی، قصیدہ، آزاد نظم، قطع، رباعی اور غزل میں طبع آزمائی کی ہے۔ وہ انفرادی خاص لہجہ کے شاعر تھے اور ان کا اسلوب منفرد تھا۔ وہ نہ صرف اچھے شاعر بلکہ بلند پایہ نثر نگار بھی تھے۔ ان کے دوسرے شعری مجموعے ”غنچہ لب بستہ“ پر ان کا لکھا ہوا دیباچہ ان کی انشاء پردازی اور ناقدانہ صلاحیتوں کا مظہر ہے۔ اگر وہ اس جانب توجہ دیتے تو اردو نثر میں بھی پیش بہا اضافہ ممکن تھا۔ انہوں نے عبدالقیوم خاں باقی سے باضابطہ تلمذ اختیار کیا اور ان سے مشورہ سخن کرتے رہے۔ ان کا پہلا مجموعہ کلام ”گرفت نظر“ دوسرے ”غنچہ لب بستہ“ اور تیسرا مجموعہ کلام ”اوج عرش“ (جو نعتوں اور منقبتوں پر مشتمل ہے) زیور طبع سے آراستہ ہو چکے ہیں۔ ذیل میں ان کے چند منتخبہ اشعار درج کئے جاتے ہیں۔
