We had a brand new venue for this year's show, which proved to be an excellent move, with plenty of show car and spectator parking. We did have one big, last minute challenge to work out. We received a late call on Friday that Mike Perry and his crew all had a stomach virus and could not do his famous burgers for the show. Our A-Team put their heads together and put a plan into action . . . PIZZA! We bought a bunch of pizzas, soft drinks and plates and set up the "Cool Cruiser Pizza Cafe!" This proved successful and we heard no complaints.

We also celebrated Andy Sarratt's 80th birthday along with Sharon Ellis' (not 80) and Susan Miller (also not 80) with a birthday cake that we shared with all.

The car show drew 75 cars (70 registered) which is about a third less than normal. We are guessing the rain delay, cold start and a new venue contributed to this, but nonetheless, we had a great show and a lot of fun!

We raised \$1,750 to help fight breast cancer with 100% of the funds staying right here in Georgia. We do have a *LONG* list of thank yous to hand out! From pulling the Club trailer to the show to setting up, running registration, selling 50/50 tickets, parking show cars, tearing down and packing up, and even being pressed into working food service!
