## **Our new Lunch Partner!**

This year, we are excited to announce that we are partnering with Meals on Wheels of Lancaster to provide our lunch service. Our relationship with Meals on Wheels (MOW) will enable us to provide our students with nutritious, delicious, well-balanced and interesting meals everyday. Specifics of the program include:

- Each day our students and faculty will have the option of either a hot or cold meal and their choice of a drink (either the juice of the day or milk).
- Lunch choices will now be made on a monthly basis. Attached you will find the weekly lunch options for the remaining weeks in September.
- All lunch orders for the month must be placed by the required due date. We are unable to add orders past this date.
- No more trying to keep track of your lunch account balance. Payments will be made by check or cash and should be attached to your student's lunch order for the month. For those families with more than one student purchasing lunch, totals can be combined and one check written for the family. Checks need to be written for the exact amount of your purchased meals.
- Unfortunately, we will no longer be able to offer milk to our students who pack a lunch. If your student is bringing a packed lunch, it must be a complete lunch including a drinks.
- We do ask for your patience while we all adjust to this new program. We truly believe that MOW is an answer to our prayers and we are excited to have such a community focused partner.



Meals on Wheels of Lancaster is the premier home delivered meal program for the area. Serving over 175,000 meals annually, we have recently begun to expand our services beyond our traditional base of home bound seniors, individuals living with disabilities, and people recovering from surgery. We now make daily, catered meals for Moravian Adult Daycare program and are excited to bring on St. Anne's as an expansion of how we can make exciting and excellent nutrition programs available to better the wholistic wellness of the community. Of equal importance is our destination as a volunteer location. We are proud to be a place where people can chip in for a few hours a day and be a part of an amazing enterprise of good. We boast over 100 daily volunteers, 579 people have volunteered with us this year, committing 31,246 hours of volunteering (by the way, that's over 3.6 YEARS worth of hours).
