## Responsive/Competitive Grants:

No LOI. Application opens April 6, 2020 and closes May 4, 2020 at 4:30 PM.

Each year the Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona collaborates with The Arizona Community Foundation (ACF)-Cochise. Cooperatively each organization funds grants up to \$5,000 for one year .

The Legacy Foundation accepts applications for grants pertaining specifically to *population health and community wellness*. All other grant requests are made directly to ACF-Cochise

LOI opens June 8, 2020 and closed August 10, 2020 at 4:30 PM. Application opens August 31, 2020 and closes September 28, 2020 at 4:30 PM.

Each year the Legacy Foundation offers Innovative Grants up to \$50,000 a year for up to two years (\$100,000 max). These projects must meet at least one of the Innovative criteria contained within the grant guidelines link below.

Application opens January 27, 2020 and closes February 7, 2020 at 4:30 PM. Participants will be selected by February 14, 2020. The Fast Pitch presentation will be February 19, 2020.
