Minutes of regular June meeting were read and accepted.

Old Business

- Info: We watched a video on using water on an electrical fire. DO NOT APPLY WATER TO ANY LINE OR JUNCTION BOX!!
- **Info:** Engine 5 has been updated with new extrication tools at station 1. Engine 4 is still out of service with issues with engine control module (ejection control module?).
- Info: Discussed ladder training that took place last week in partnership with Sebago FD.

New Business

- Info: Forestry 1 had an issue with throttle pedal. The drive pin was replaced. Currently in service.
- **Info:** Fire department infrastructure needs to be proactive in response to the rapid growth in the town in the past 3 years and projected growth. Commercial applications will need review to insure adequate response for fire suppression.
 - Disc golf, bar, restaurant and walking trails across from BCC.
 - Boat sales and storage off of 107 near Sand Pond.
 - Proposal for agricultural grow near Hall Road.
- Info: Discussion on water sources to support growth. Current water sources are shrinking.
- Info: Currently we have two requests for controlled burns.
 - Bishop Delliso Lane. This is barn structure in back of house fire responded to earlier in the year. Possibly scheduled toward end of August.
 - Barn on 113 across from Chase Road. Burn is scheduled for August 7th.
- **Training:** Maine Fire Service Institute pump certification training will be scheduled sometime in October.
- Info: Plans are in place to create a 4-man certified interior attack team in partnership with Sebago FD.

- **Training:** Arial ladder training is available in Gorham on August 1st.
- **Training:** Will be scheduling first aide training during the winter months.
- **Training:** If you have received EVOC training and need to be recertified, recertification is available through Rescue1 Academy.
- Info: Call boxes have been updated to provide a more efficient response.
- Info: Discussion on response to Long Hill Road near Murch Road. The road has been broken up into 2 districts to align with Baldwin and Sebago response.
- Info: Discussion on water rescue. Currently we do not have water access on the Baldwin side of the Saco River.
