Technology: Computers and PoE switch for the new telephone system have been installed. Cozad Telephone is in the process of getting our new phone system up and working. Have reached out to Integrated Security Solutions to see where they are on upgrading our alarm system, as I signed off on that in December.

Landscaping/Building: HVAC Unit 4 is installed. Amazing how much warmer the library is! Skylight is here, waiting for good weather to install; roof after. Axxent says windows will be installed soon~as soon as they are, I will contact Five Star to install carpet.

Staff: Hired Klaylee Revelo, a junior at Cozad High School. She began on January 2. As she is very involved with speech and one acts, Jennifer Gengenbach agreed to serve as a substitute, but won't be available until late February. Staff still ok with switching out Saturdays and Laura has been working 9-6 to help train Klaylee. I will be at a conference in Kansas January 31-February 1st and was awarded a Central Plains Library System Grant to offset that cost, so it does not affect our budget. We have been open 9am-6pm since January 2. Interestingly, it's been busier than normal from 5-6 per staff, so they are trying to adjust to doing closing processes while people are still in the building. It's slow from 9-10, but I think as people learn about our new hours, they'll take advantage of coming in earlier. The janitor has been doing some adjustments with us opening an hour early.

Jennie and I are working with Dawson County Extension as far as a biodiversity grant and trying to partner with Cozad Middle School. We're half-way through inventory and hope to finish that by the end of the month. The State Report will go in on Monday, hopefully.
