

Field & Crop Update From Chad (June 2014)

Some corn fields are experiencing the after effects of the cold snap that occurred in mid-May. Some plants look a little stunted and yellow, even under high fertility situations.



It seems like some of the earlier planted corn may have been affected more than the later planted corn.

A number of clients have asked what we can do to remedy this problem. As long as the proper amounts of N, P, and K have been applied, there really is no quick fix.

Hopefully, we can get some warm growing conditions in the high 80s and low 90s to help bring the stunted corn plants along.

All is not lost in these areas. Just be patient.
