NOT FOR PROFIT APPLICATION STATUS - Bridgette is working with accountant, the club will need to
update by-laws and update website BOD listing, as well as removing "social group" from description
TRAIL HANKIES - update on prices & sponsors \$4.25each if 300 are ordered, \$200 to be a sponsor
and be listed on the hankie, no response from sponsors yet
CORRALS - next sites we will focus on electric sites in upper loop, followed by non electric in lower
loop, Julie from West 20 is a preferred Preifert dealer and can work with our pending not for profit
status. We can save \$100 per gate by using one of the existing gates from each 24x24 corrals

	<b>ApDRAW Disbanding</b> : Dawn and Jim Haas announced that ApDRAW will be disbanding. This local endurance group has been an active supporter of our club, the local trails and campground for 40 years, and will greatly be missed. ApDRAW has donated \$4000 of their remaining funds to be used specifically for new corrals at Horseriders' Campground in Palmyra! Thank you Dawn, Jim and ApDRAW!
	<b>Electric Site Expansion:</b> the WI Zoning regulations have changed, and it is possible we may be able to add more electric campsites to Horseriders' Campground. Without a Trail Coordinator, we do not have a dedicated DNR liaison for the club, and communication sent from the BOD has not been receiving responses. We will continue to try to communicate and get updates and confirmation from the DNR.
	<b>Camp Host</b> : Thank you to Fawn R for volunteering her spring and early summer time to hosting at Palmyra! The Camp Host site is currently vacant. Volunteers should contact DNR Ranger Chris or apply online. All applicants must pass a background check which takes a few weeks, but once approved, are good for two years.
