
of Religions

Join us this fall for an adult forum series presented by parishioner John Herbert, a former Roman Catholic deacon with an MA in Theology, focusing on Interfaith Studies. The series begins Sunday, September 9th, at 9am in the adult forum room. This adult education series will be divided into six parts, beginning with a history of religion(s) as we have come to understand them, followed by an in-depth look at the Abrahamic Faiths; Judaism, Christianity and Islam. A closer look will be taken at the various denominations of Christianity, where we will identify their similarities and differences. Our sessions will end by exploring Hinduism, the oldest known religion in the world, along with Buddhism, Jainism and the Sikh and Baha'i faiths. Famed University of Chicago theologian Martin E. Marty once said, "Religion is the cause of most of the killing in the world today. It is also responsible for most of the healing in the world today." With this in mind, the goal of this class will be to learn the facts about various faiths, providing us with an understanding of love and peace, so we can walk with all others as we search for a better understanding of our God.

Meditation Sessions






