## I. PURPOSE

The Northwest Suburban Integration School District #6078 (NWSISD) has been established as an expression of its member school districts' mutual commitment to a racially integrated metropolitan area, to equal educational opportunities for all children, and to the enhancement of educational opportunities through inter-district educational options in integrated settings.

# II. MAGNET SCHOOLS

Magnet schools have been established to further the above purpose.

## III. ELIGIBILITY

All students residing in member districts that include magnet schools in their Achievement and Integration (AI) plans are eligible to apply and attend a NWSISD magnet school.

# **MAGNET SCHOOLS APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

## I. THE APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- A. All students applying for a position at a magnet school must submit an online application. An application must be submitted for each child, in the event of multiple siblings applying from the same household.
- B. The link to an application form will be found on the NWSISD website during open application periods. The first open application period is the priority application period.
- C. Application periods will be determined annually.
- D. Although the timeline for this process coincides with the open enrollment process for individual member districts, an application to a magnet program does not constitute an application to a member district's open enrollment program. Parents wishing to participate in a district's open enrollment process must separately submit an open enrollment application with that district.
- E. A student may choose up to two magnet schools in order of preference on the NWSISD magnet school application, depending on the number of magnet programs available at their grade level.
