



Postoperative Instructions for

HAND CARE

- 1. To avoid the spread of contagious disease and infection, wash your hands frequently especially before incision care, and avoid ill visitors.
- 2. **Elevate** your hand above the level of your heart for 3 days to prevent swelling and pain. Elevate the involved extremity on pillows at night. If you have a sling on to help with elevation and comfort, discontinue when desired.
- 3. Ice the area of surgery 1 hour 4-5 times per day for the first 1-2 days. If ice too cold, ice 30 minutes at a time.

4. **Dressing:** if too tight, loosen the top wrap, ice and elevate-observe for evidence of swelling or discoloration. If

- this does not relieve the pressure call us or the Bone and Joint Center.

 Do not remove dressing until appointment— keep clean and dry. Shower with a plastic bag over your dressing. If the dressing becomes wet, dry with a hair dryer. Bloody drainage on the dressing is normal; however, if it continues to increase after elevation & ice please call.

 Keep dressing on, clean and dry until______. Take dressing off, cover with plastic, shower. After shower cover incision(s) with band-aid & change daily; keep incisions clean and dry. Do not use any ointments on incisions.

 Exercise: Move your freed fingers, elbow, and shoulder throughout the day to prevent stiffness. Please refer to "Terri's Routine" handout. Start tomorrow, as tolerated.

 Pain medication_____ Take it with food to avoid upset stomach. *For uncontrolled pain or reaction, call your doctor's office. Resume your home meds. You may take ibuprofen/ Advil/ Aleve as needed if okay with your regular doctor. Question any side effects or drug interactions with your pharmacist.

- 8. Call the Bone and Joint Center for any **signs of wound infection**: increased swelling, pain, warm to touch, redness, drainage, fever (temperature greater than 100.5).
- 9. If you have any questions or problems, please call your doctor. **After hours call PrimeCare Operator**, 1-701-530-5588 and have the on-call Bone and Joint physician paged for you.
