Wartime in the Vale - Conditions of Entry

Please read this **before** signing your entry form:

1. Entries must be presented in a complete and safe working condition. Please display your entry pass at all times.
2. All entries must be insured for third party risk and road vehicles must be fully licensed (where applicable) and tested in accordance with existing construction and use regulations for the class of vehicle. Please have your original insurance certificate with you, an official may ask to inspect it. Failure to comply will imply that the vehicle is not insured, in which case it will only be allowed on site as a static display.
3. Owners must ensure that all drivers are fully competent and permitted by law (licensed and insured) to operate the vehicle.
4. **DRIVERS** – Unlicensed drivers, especially children, will not be permitted to drive any vehicle, including quad bikes and mini motorcycles however powered on the show, camping or parking fields. The same laws apply on the show field at all times, as on the public highway.
REMEMBER DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE
5. **PASSENGERS** – will not ride on any vehicles (except on properly constructed seats) on any of the fields occupied by the show. Exceptions may be granted for arena displays by prior agreement with the show safety officer.
6. No exhibit may be left running unattended, all exhibits must be securely braked or chocked.
7. **FUEL** – will not be transferred on the site on any permeable surface.
8. Exhibitors will not move any vehicle on the show field, except to and from the arena, during public opening times without the prior permission of the show organisers or their officers. We recommend motor-cyclists should wear approved crash helmets.
9. A strictly enforced maximum speed limit of 5mph will apply throughout the rally site during daylight. Movement after dark will only be allowed with the permission of the safety officer or one of his staff. All armoured vehicle movements will have a walking attendant preceding the vehicle to clear the way. Please take care and be aware of children and pedestrians at all times.
10. No additional vehicle may be brought onto the site without prior permission, free vehicle parking is available in the public car park adjacent to the show field. All non-show vehicles must be parked either in the public car park or in the civilian camping area.
11. Exhibitors and their parties must pay full regard to rally officials/marshals instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience or endanger any persons at any time.
12. For non-military classics, only vehicles pre-1950 may register.
13. **Details of acceptance and vehicle passes will be sent in due course, these will permit entry for a maximum of 2 adults and 2 children only, additional persons must pay the normal gate admission charges.**
14. **CAMPING AND CARAVANS** – These units are to be sited on the field as instructed by the show organisers in accordance with Caravan Club guidelines (A minimum of 2 metres from the adjoining unit, to include awning if used. **Only green military tents allowed in the display sections.**
15. Camp fires are allowed, provided you have a working modern fire extinguisher to hand.
16. All vehicles and living history displays must be equipped with working modern fire extinguishers.
17. **WEAPONS** – No weapons are to be discharged or carried on site except by arrangement with the safety officer or one of his staff. Edged weapons must remain sheathed at all times (no exceptions). Deactivated weapons must be accompanied by a valid deactivation certificate. Live weapons are not permitted on site except by prior arrangement, no live ammunition is permitted on any part of the site.
18. The use of any pyrotechnics, except where permitted in an arena display, is prohibited. **Anyone failing to observe this rule will be asked to leave the site immediately.**
19. **DOGS** – To be kept on a lead at all times & be aware that there will be loud bangs during the course of the show, and fireworks in the evening.
20. We appreciate exhibitors may have to leave the showground prior to the closing time of 5pm on the Sunday evening, if so please drive very slowly and carefully with a walking attendant preceding the vehicle.
