HOLLIDAY NATURE PRESERVE WESTLAND

May 4

This hike will focus on wildflowers along the Tonquish Creek.

Meet at the Cowan section of Preserve, Central City Parkway between Wayne and Warren.



LOLA VALLEY REDFORD

May 11

We will hike partially along the edge of this Rouge River tributary and look at natural wonders.

Meet at Kinloch Comfort Station, Kinloch Street south of Lola Drive.

LOWER ROUGE TRAIL CANTON

July 20

Trail offers a good surface and the hike will focus on the diversity of various habitats.

Meet at Morton Taylor Trailhead, west of Morton Taylor and north of Michigan Avenue.

BENNETT ARBORETUM NORTHVILLE

August 17

This hilly terrain hike will focus on a few of the specimens of trees.

Meet at Cass Benton Disc Golf parking lot, Hines Drive between Six and Seven Mile.

Colonial Park INKSTER

June 1

A hike on a paved trail will focus on summer flora and fauna.

Meet near the comfort station in the park, at the intersection of Inkster and Colonial.

NEWBURGH LAKE LIVONIA

November 2

We will hike along the lake to see what nature we can find in the hilly terrain.

Meet at the trailhead parking lot on the west end of Newburgh Lake, off of Hines Drive.



Recommended for ages 12 to adult. Program fee is \$3.00 per person, add \$1.00 for non-Wayne County residents. Pre-registration is required 48 hours before the program. No refunds unless Wayne County Parks cancels.
