
## Book Club Gathering

For January, we are reading *How We Learn to Be Brave* by Mariann Edgar Budde, 2023. This inspirational book by Bishop Mariann Budde teaches readers to respond with clarity and grace even in the toughest times. Being brave is a journey that we can choose to undertake every day. Drawing on examples from Harry Potter to the Gospel According to Luke, Bishop Budde weaves together personal experiences with stories from scripture, history, and pop culture. Margaret will lead the discussion. The public library has 17 books, 4 eBooks, and 10 downloadable audiobooks.



Coming February 24: *The Book of Lost Names* by Kristin Harmel, 2020. This WWII historical fiction is about Eva Traube, a young Jewish woman in occupied France who becomes a forger for the Resistance, creating fake identities for Jewish children escaping to Switzerland. She keeps a secret ledger to record their true identities. A dual narrative follows elderly Eva in 2005 confronting her past and the discovered book.
