Resolution: Establishment of Charges for the Hickman County Emergency Communications District

WHEREAS, the Hickman County Emergency Communications District plays a crucial role in providing efficient emergency communication services to the residents of Hickman County, Tennessee.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish charges for addressing and mapping services provided by the Hickman County Emergency Communication District, in accordance with provisions of the Tennessee Code Annotated 7–86–101; and 7–86–127.

WHEREAS, the establishment of charges will enable the Hickman County Emergency Communications District to sustain and enhance its services to ensure the safety and well-being of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following charges are hereby established for the Hickman County Emergency Communications District, effective August 1, 2024:

- 1. Individual Residential Addressing Fee:
  - 1.1. \$100 for up to 10 individual addresses per development
  - 1.2. Flat rate of \$25 for returning due to failure of completing application requirements
  - 1.3. Flat rate of \$2,000 per phase for more than 10 addresses per development
- 2. Reserving a Street Name:
  - 2.1. \$100 per single residents
  - 2.2. Flat rate of \$25 for returning due to failure of completing application requirements
  - 2.3. This reservation will sunset after 12 months for residential and/or 24 months for commercial or subdivision development from the date of application should the development not move forward. Any fees paid will be forfeited. Any fees collected for reserving a street name are not included in the maximum cost for a subdivision phase. Any fees collected are non-refundable or inapplicable to any separate project.
- 3. Adding Subdivision Streets:
  - 3.1. \$500 per street for up to 10 streets per phase
  - 3.2. Flat rate of \$5,000 per phase for additional streets

- 4. Maximum Developmental Cost of Subdivision Phase:
  - 4.1. A maximum of \$7,000 per subdivision phase will be assessed
- 5. Governmental agencies and chartered non-profit organizations are exempt from these charges but must still adhere to the process for addressing and street naming.

The Hickman County Emergency Communication District shall have the authority to collect these charges in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceeds generated from these charges shall be dedicated to the improvement, maintenance, and enhancement of the addressing and mapping services provided by the Hickman County Emergency Communication District.

This resolution shall take effect on August 1, 2024, and shall supersede any previous resolutions or provisions that may be inconsistent with the charges established herein.
