Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an ILP/PAL number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This event is accepting entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made by 6 pm, the Monday before the trial.. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the trial ends each day.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. Important Notice To Exhibitors

We would like this event to be a pleasant experience for all in attendance. We ask your cooperation, please, in the following areas:

1. This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.
2. The trial site will be open to participants starting at 2:00 pm, Thursday, the day before the first day of the trial. All dogs and personal belongings must be removed by one hour after the trial ends on Sunday.
3. Participants who leave dogs, equipment and personal belongings unattended, do so at their own risk. The show giving club(s) and the owner(s) of the site will not be responsible for dogs, equipment or personal belongings, nor for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
4. NO ALCOHOL will be permitted anywhere on the premises or grounds and NO SMOKING will be permitted in the building. Please respect this site!
5. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. Dogs (even on leash) are not permitted in the concessions area.
6. Ample parking and areas for crating dogs. RV hookups available by prior reservation only.
7. Food concessions will be available during the trials.
8. Participants will be responsible for clean conditions (including picking up after the dogs in their care) around crates, parking spaces and hookups.
9. Bitches in season and injured dogs shall not be eligible to participate. Partial refunds (minus \$5 per run) will be given for bitches in season. A letter from a veterinarian on their letterhead is required by the Trial Chair prior to the beginning of the trial for a refund.
10. Dogs must be ready to compete. The judge need not wait for any dog that is not ready to compete when the gate steward calls its number.
11. The judges will take a half-hour lunch break at a convenient time.
12. Participants shall be governed by any rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or location restrictions. Please obey all posted signs.
13. Parents or guardians must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision of an adult at all times.
14. Vehicles will be allowed to park in designated areas only. Vehicles parked in undesignated areas will be towed at the owner's expense.
15. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.
16. Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
17. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

The Trial site will be available to exhibitors at 3:00 PM till 8:00 PM on Thursday before the trial. NO EXCEPTIONS. All dogs and personal belongings must be removed by one hour after the trial ends on Sunday.

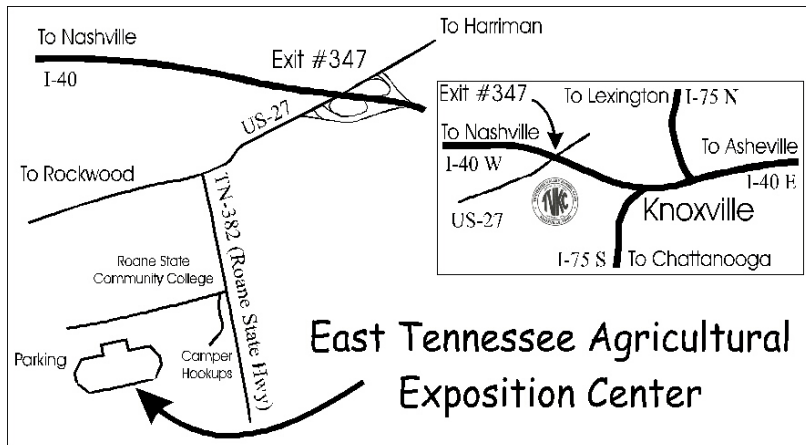
MAP & DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Knoxville: Take I-40 West towards Nashville. Go about 35 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From Nashville: Take I-40 East towards Knoxville. Go about 130 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Keep LEFT at the fork in the exit ramp. Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.1 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From Chattanooga: Take I-75 North towards Knoxville. Go about 85 miles and take the I-40 West exit (LEFT fork). Go about 20 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From US-27: To TN-382 and Roane State Community College (RSCC). Turn LEFT onto 382 towards RSCC. Go 1.0 miles, passing RSCC on the right, and immediately turn RIGHT towards the Expo Center parking areas. The Expo Center will be on your left. Follow signs to competitor's parking areas on the north and west sides of the building. Do not block driveways on the arena level entrances! **Camper hookups** are on the east side of the building. When you turn RIGHT off TN-382, make an immediate LEFT. Follow signs for camper hookups.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. ORKC Agility Trial - COVID-19 Rules April 2 – 4, 2021

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and even death. According to the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with pre-existing conditions are exceptionally vulnerable. By entering this trial, you voluntarily assume all risks related to COVID-19 exposure.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the following rules will be in place during our trial. These rules will be in effect from the Thursday setup and continue through the end of the trial on Sunday. While we are doing the best we can to make this event as safe as possible, there may still be risk of infection/exposure that we don't know about or cannot control. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, then please do not enter our trial. Additional rules and regulations are based on recommendations from both the CDC and the AKC.

Masks – Masks will be required to be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building, and while outside within 25 feet of the arena. Please bring at least one mask with you for your personal use. Masks will be required while you are in the ring running your dog. Our judges will also be wearing a mask while not in the ring. **If you have a medical condition that prevents you from wearing a mask please do not enter this trial.**

Please apply 6ft social distancing at all times.

Illness – IF YOU ARE ILL, DO PLEASE NOT COME! If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days or if you yourself have tested positive in the last 14 days – PLEASE DO NOT COME! Exhibitors – We are limiting this trial to exhibitors only. The general public will not be allowed to watch, in an effort to limit the total number of people onsite. Should you or an immediate family member be diagnosed with COVID-19 after the closing date of our trial, your entry payment will be reimbursed.

Ringside - Our goal is to ONLY have the next dog on line and 3 more teams with 6ft spacing ringside. Please wait in the hallway or outside until you are called.

Personal Hygiene - Please wash your hands frequently. If possible bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you. We will endeavor to have larger bottles available for competitors to refill their own bottles if necessary. Hand sanitizer will be at each of the Scribe/Timer tables and also at the ribbon table.

Concessions – Concessions will not be available at this trial. Please bring your own food and drink as there are no restaurants close by.

Leashes - If possible, please think about using a lightweight leash that you can either put in your pocket or tie around your body.

Walkthroughs – We will be limiting the size of walkthroughs if necessary. The final confirmation letter will have an approximate time range, but this may change. Please pay attention to any changes that are announced.

Ribbons - Stickers and a variety of ribbons will also be available on a "self-serve" basis, but there will be "Xs" on the floor to indicate 6ft spacing. Again, PLEASE be respectful of social distancing.

Trial Secretary - Please again respect social distancing. A 6ft mark will be placed on the floor.

MACH/PACH parties – Unfortunately, for everyone's safety, there will be no MACH/PACH or other celebratory events at this trial. There will not be a central communal table or pens available for MACH/PACH bars to be signed.

Doors – We will mark doors as "In" or "Out" wherever possible. This is to reduce cross-traffic. Please follow the instructions on these signs.

Changes to rules – We may make changes to these rules prior to the start of the trial. BE SURE to read your confirmation letter to see what changes have been made. By entering the trial and signing the COVID waiver, you are agreeing to abide by all rules. Failure to follow the rules will be dealt with according to AKC regulations, up to and including requiring you to leave the trial site and bench committee hearings.

With all these additional requirements, we still hope that you and your dog will have fun getting back to running agility. Stepping into the ring, it will just be you and your dog and enjoying the thrill our sport offers us. Obviously it is not as it used to be, but hopefully, with all of us taking individual responsibility for our own actions we will have a safe and enjoyable trial.
