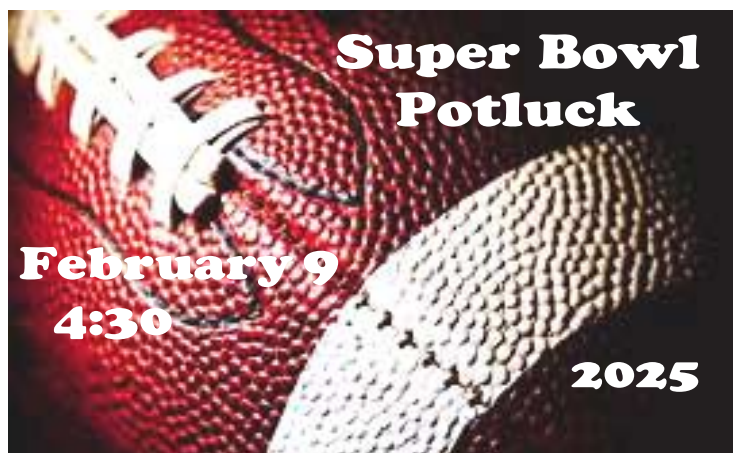

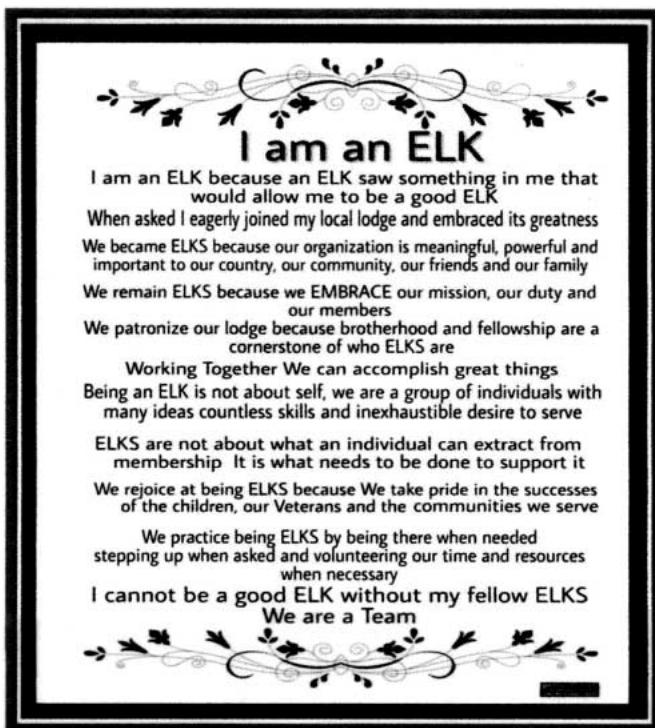
## Dear Members:
