

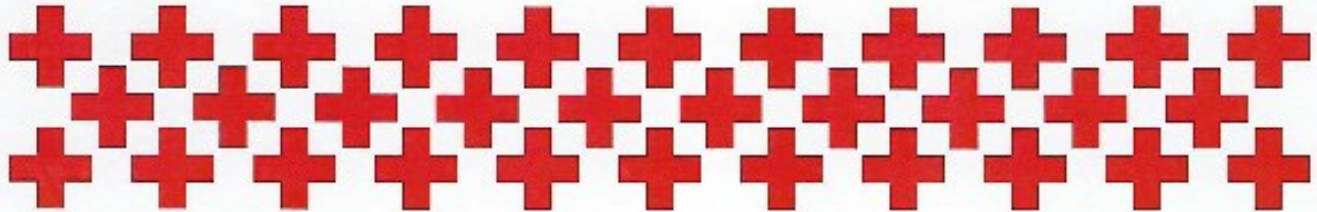

Sheridan Businesses, we would like a current photo of your business and team. We will be collecting everything we can this year to document our history. Please help us to complete this large task.

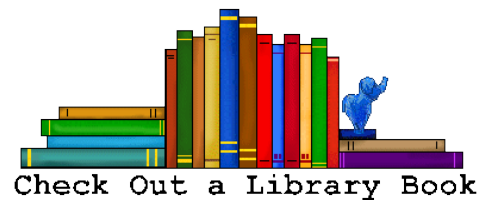

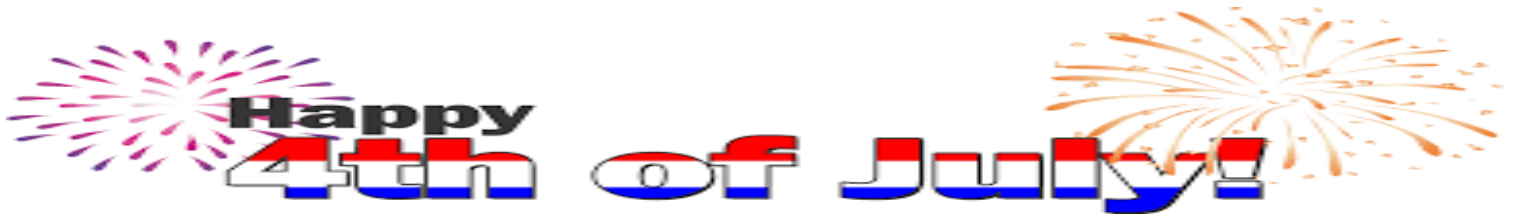
