The materials investigation for the Mill Creek Dam which was prepared by Rollins, Brown & Gunnell, Inc. was reviewed. It was decided that Director Norman and Secretary Hoffman should investigate the possibility of obtaining a suitable option on the gravel deposit at the mouth of the canyon which is owned by Dan O'Laurie.

Chairman McDougald reported that Bob Morgan has asked the district to obtain five or six suitable sites West of Main Street to file for maximum well water rights. It was determined that this approach should be pursued and all agreed to attend the City Council meeting this date to request several of the sites on City properties.

Director Rogers moved that the district request the Utah Oil and Gas Commission to require casing and cementing thru the near surface aquifers on the oil well which is being drilled by Union Texas Petroleum and Serio Exploration along the West side of Spanish Valley across from the Rodeo grounds and that the district also file for a water right at the site in the amount of 5 CFS. Director Taylor seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Secretary Hoffman reported that Loren Laughlin may have an industrial use for the Cisco water.




