The Brazen-Faced Varlets are bringing Jessica Dickey's *The Convent* to Buffalo this November at the Compass Performing Arts Center. Dickey's piece keeps with the Varlets' mission of producing nonconformist theatre, featuring an eclectic group of women attending a stringent retreat in a medieval-style convent. Despite their severe environment, they are soon baptized with eighties pop, female mysticism, hallucinogens, and sex, a combination which leads them to explore desire, devotion, and intrinsic divinity.

The show marks Artie-nominated actor Stefanie Warnick's directorial debut with the Varlets. She reflects, "I don't think I could have asked for a better script and cast... the chemistry in the rehearsal room is palpable! These amazing actors are bringing the words to life and I can't wait to share this story with Buffalo." Sandra Roberts, who plays the truth-telling hellraiser, Patti, feels the positive energy as well. They say "working with the Varlets for the first time has been so inviting and delicious! Roberts is joined on stage by four time Artie-winning actor, Pamela Rose Mangus: as well as Juli Gryier, Rachael Buchanan, and Gabrielle Nunzio. Last but not least, *The Convent* stars co-founders Heather Fangsrud and Lara D. Haberberger who were both nominated for the Varlets' production of 'night Mother in 2018.

The Convent is a 90-minute performance with no intermission. Shows take place November 3rd through 18th at the Compass Performing Arts Center. Thursdays and Fridays performances are at 7:30 PM and Saturday performances are at 5:00 PM. The house will open 30 minutes prior to each performance.
