RESOLUTION NO.: SL - 12 - 2024

**TITLE: APPROVAL OF THE UPDATED FISH AND WILDLIFE
HARVEST PROCEDURE**

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 8, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the responsibility for the general welfare of its tribal membership including tribal natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect, and advance the views, interest, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council supports natural resources management that protects, conserves, and enhances plants and wildlife native to the Summit Lake basin and aboriginal area of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has organized a Natural Resources Department (NRD) to provide technical expertise and services to manage air, water, soil, fish, wildlife, and plants within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation and off Reservation areas considered the aboriginal homeland of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the NRD has developed an updated harvest process (of which the new elements are voluntary) to streamline interactions with state and federal fish and wildlife law enforcement officers regarding fish and wildlife harvest from the Reservation, and to provide the NRD with valuable harvest data to inform sustainable management of the Reservation's fish and wildlife populations; and

WHEREAS, the updated harvest procedure includes an updated harvest permit, a new harvest tag to be affixed to the animal, and drop boxes at the Reservation and Sparks to drop off the tear off portion of the tags; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby approves for the NRD to rollout the updated harvest procedure; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council does not waive, alter, or otherwise diminish its Sovereign Immunity, whether expressed or

implied, by virtue of this grant contract for any and all administrative or legal action which may arise directly or indirectly from the same. Furthermore, the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairwoman to execute any instruments as may be necessary and appropriate to accomplish the above-mentioned actions in the name of and on behalf of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.
