Opening – Brian Boehm (present):

- Brian called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Introduction of Officers

Secretary's Report – Steve Thurmond (present):

- May meeting minutes were read and approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report – Bill Means (present):

- Income year to date 16,523.39
- Expenses YTD: -\$12,573.90
- Net Income YTD: \$4,281.12

Membership Report – Steve Close: (present):

- Currently we have 66 regular members and 12 seniors for a total of 78.
- Collected \$1040 in dues.
- 16 dues reminders were sent out.
- No work credits were reported for May.
- 0 first readings.

Rifle Team – (Rifle chair position is vacant):

- Rifle league is completed for the year with no updates provided from John Lathrop who ran the league. Club secretary texted John and John stated he would be putting together a recap.
- Details of Emmy Walrath match participation/results were presented by Jon Speck and he will provide written details for minutes.

Pistol League – Bill Means (present):

- Sign up sheets for the fall rim fire league is posted in the club/range and also on the website.

Webmaster – Jon Speck (present):

- Jon asked that if any information or updates be e-mailed to him for web updates.
- No one has stepped up to take the position after Jon advised the club that he is stepping down.

Rental Property – Tony Del Frate (present):

- Tenant is currently paid up as of June 10th.
- Garage door needs repaired; Tony is investigating.
- Club needs to get a new lawnmower, so tenant is able to cut the grass.
- Septic tank for rental was pumped out before end of June. Septic for range also needs to be pumped/inspected to avoid a \$200 fine. Tony will take care of this issue.
- There was an incident of an intruder in the house behind the rental, not in the club's rental. Intruder was arrested. This was unsettling to the tenant.

Match Director – Dora Potekin (not present):

Hunter Education – Beau Bosovich (Not present):
