Regular Meeting ----- October 8, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the Vice-Chairman, Gary Wilson at 7:00 A.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Bobbie Domenick and James Walker.

After calling for additions or corrections to the MINUTES minutes of the meeting of September 24, 1992, Bobbie Domenick moved the minutes be approved as circulated to the Board. Bill McDougald seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Dale reported the leaks in the inlet at the lake LEAKS IN KEN'S had been excavated and the contractor is proceeding with filling with fabric and sand, then they will add the clay layer. After a question, Dale stated he planned to shut off the irrigation system the 2nd of November. Dale also stated the City of Moab wanted to pump the Corbin Well to take samples, and would utilize the irrigation system as a place to pump the well to. This pumping will take place after the system is shut off and lake water drained.

James Walker asked about the measuring device in TUNNEL METER the tunnel and was told it had been fixed in July. Gary asked if we might excavate in the inlet to dredge out the sand and if we did it every year it would probably be more It has been estimated we had lost 5 or 6 acre DREDGING economical. feet of storage in the reservoir due to silt build-up. Dale was asked to consult with Boulden as to cost.

The financial statement was gone over on a line by FINANCIAL line basis.

Bobbie moved to approve the checks. James Walker seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

James Walker asked if there was any overuse on the irrigation system. Dale replied a few people had been contacted after the mid-year readings because they were showing a trend towards overuse, but the final reading for the season has not been made.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 A.M.
