I agree to obtain, at my own expense, all licenses and permits required by the State of Iowa, Jackson County, the City of Maquoketa and provide the Maquoketa Farmers Market with copies prior to vending.

If I am claiming to sell Certified Organic Products, I will provide a copy of the certificate to the Maquoketa Farmers Market prior to vending.

If I am selling *"Temperature Controlled for Safety"* foods (formally - Potentially Hazardous *Foods*) at the market, I will obtain, and comply with, a State of Iowa Farmer's Market License. I will provide a copy of the license to the Maquoketa Farmers Market prior to vending.

Indemnification:

The Market Manager will be present to supervise the market and any other activities that the market may be having. If you have any questions or concerns or any problems arise, please let the market manager know. They will be dealt with during that event and the market manager's decision shall be final. An appeal of the decision may be requested and reviewed by the market committee before the next event date.

MARKET SEASON

The 2018 market will begin May 15th and run thru October 16th. *Hours of operation are from 4:00 – 6:30 pm. Rain or Shine!* Set up time to start no earlier than 3:00 pm and tear down to start no earlier than 6:30 pm.

VENDOR FEES

Each vendor must purchase a Full Season Pass for \$75 (\$80 after May 1) or pay the Occasional Vendors Rate of \$10 per day **All vendors must submit a completed and signed Vendor Application form, submit a Certificate of Liability Insurance, a Sales Tax Certificate (if applicable), and all necessary permits <u>before</u> selling at the Maquoketa Farmers Market.**

VENDOR EXPECTATIONS

The Maquoketa Farmers Market encourages all vendors to charge a fair and reasonable price for their goods. *Underselling will not be permitted*.

ENFORCEMENT of RULES and REGULATIONS

The first offense will result in a written warning. A second offense will result in a \$25 penalty. Repeat offenders may lose their vending privileges for the season with no refund of fees.

RULES and REGULATIONS

No smoking is permitted in the market area.

No firearms/weapons or illicit drugs are permitted in the market area.

No pets are allowed at the market, with the exception of licensed service animals.

No animals are allowed to be sold or given away.

Each vendor is responsible for supplying a suitable trash receptacle for their own and public use. All trash must be taken with you when you leave. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean.

No sales may be made or products held back for the customers prior to the bell ringing. You cannot hold back items or bag produce before market starts.

No vendor shall attract attention to products by outcry in a boisterous or annoying manner. Vendors shall not solicit customers who have not voluntarily approached their stall.

Spaces will be *assigned* for the season. Occasional vendors will be assigned an open space at the manager's discretion. If vendor has not arrived by 3:30, without prior notification to the market manager, the space is subject to reassignment for that date.

Vendors shall furnish their own tables, chairs and shade. PLEASE keep your area clean. Nothing turns away customers more quickly than dirty tables, vegetables, or containers.

More than 65% of your product and items that you sell must be grown, made, or harvested by the vendor. If the point-of-origin is in question, an on-site inspection of the production area may be conducted. The vendor shall provide directions to the production site and grant permission for an inspection of the production site within 72 hours of notification. Artisans and Crafters must make their own products.

Vendors shall not distribute letters, pamphlets, magazines, petitions, etc. to other vendors or customers and shall not solicit vendors or customers to support other organizations or fund raising without prior approval of the Market Board. Likewise, customers shall also be discouraged from soliciting and distributing.
