NYSUT RC 7 ELECTION TO BE HELD IN MAY

RC 7 will conduct its election at the general membership meeting to be held on Tuesday, May 19th at NYSUT **Regional Office**. The Elections Committee will conduct the election, with balloting from 11:45am - 12:15pm. All NYSUT Retirees of ED 7 are eligible to vote; you do not need to attend the luncheon.

Resumes of the candidates will be published on the RC 7 website (http://nysutretireecouncil7.org) and will be available at the April 21st general membership meeting at Barbagallo's, East Syracuse. There are five (5) Officers (President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer), five (5) Directors of the Board, two (2) NYSUT Delegates, and four (4) Alternate Delegates for NYSUT and AFT on the ballot. (At the time of publication of this newsletter, the candidate resumes have been submitted but the determination of candidate eligibility had not yet been determined. For up-to-date information, please refer to the website.)

The term of office is July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2023.

IT'S TIME TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, qualifying children or grandchildren of RC 7 members (whose participation fee was paid by December 31st) are eligible to apply for an RC 7 Memorial Scholarship. Up to four scholarships of \$1000 each may be awarded. The students must be graduating from a New York State public or private high school whose staff is NYSUT affiliated and must be entering an institute of higher education at an accredited school, college, or university. The scholarships honor past RC 7 members.


