## Items We Accept without Fees

### Curbside Recyclables

- Aluminum Cans
- Cardboard & chipboard
- Glass Bottles & Jars (Clean food grade only)
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Paper: Office & Classroom
- Phone Books
- Plastic #1, #2, & #5
- Plastic Grocery Bags
- Scrap metal (steel, iron, brass, copper, aluminum)
- Shrink Wrap & Bubble Wrap
- Steel & Tin Cans

### Electronics

- Batteries (except alkaline; tape the ends and discard in trash)
- Cell phones
- Computers & Accessories (monitors incur a fee)
- Inkjet and Laser Printer cartridges
- Miscellaneous Electronics

### Household Items/Other Items

- Appliances not containing Freon
- Books
- Clothing
- F.O.G. (cooking Fats, Oils & Grease)
- Small furniture in good condition
- Home Medical Equipment
- Household items in good condition
- Metal items
- Shoes

## Items We Accept with Fees

The following items contain hazardous materials and incur a small fee in order to properly recycle.

### **SANDY SPRINGS RESIDENTS ONLY!**

### **Items with a fee should be dropped off during operating hours.**

- Appliances--**\$30.00** for items containing Freon (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, A/C units)
- TVs and Monitors
  - **\$15.00**- LCD TV/Monitor under 60"
  - **\$25.00**- LCD TV/Monitor 60" +
  - **\$30.00**- CRT TV/Monitor under 29"
  - **\$55.00**- CRT TV/Monitor 29" +
- Document Shredding --**\$0.50** per pound
- Fluorescent light bulbs
  - **\$1.00**- compact curly bulb
  - **\$2.00**- for tubes under 4 feet
  - **\$5.00**- for tubes 4 feet and over
- Smoke detectors --**\$2.00**
- Thermometers, thermostats, & other items with mercury --**\$5.00**

## Items We DO NOT Accept

- Construction Debris
- Sheet glass, plates, glasses, vases, etc.
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Mattresses and Box Springs
- Paint
- Plastics other than #1, #2, and #5
- Polystyrene (Styrofoam)
- Tanks (helium, propane, etc.)
- Tires
- Yard Waste
