REJOICING OVER A NEW BOYS HOME!

By the time you receive this newsletter, Lord willing the slab (roof/ceiling) should be finished. We're thinking this new HOPE Boys Home may be completely finished sometime in late May or early June, hopefully beating the beginning of the rainy season. A big THANKS to those of you who have prayed for this project and given donations. Continued prayers are much appreciated, especially for quality construction. Meeting the budget of \$17,500 (the donations given) would be nice too, but it's too early to tell in regard to that.

Because it's difficult to get a handle on exactly how many funds are available for other projects (for a variety of reasons), we're slowly stepping out by faith to do other smaller projects here at HOPE before the possible monsoon rains begin. We're building a large awning on one end of the HOPE girls home, along with a bathroom. In the school, we're planning on putting some walls up for 2 more classrooms, doing some more awning work to stop the rains from coming inside, but holding off on extra bathrooms until we know funds are available.

MANNA PROGRAM PROFILES

VIMALAMMA (HOPE MP): She may be in her 80's (most of our MP elderly don't know their birthdays), her husband dying around 1980. She used to work for a doctor, but hasn't been able to work for many years. She has 6 children, but none really care for her. She has lived for years on her niece's porch. She has suffered much for many years with severe headaches. The last 2 or 3 years she eats very little, and it's amazing she's still alive. Pray for her comfort, and peace in her heart while here on this earth. *"He does not forget the cry of the afflicted."* Psalms 9:12



DANAYAMMA (El Bethel MP): She is perhaps 55-60 years old, her husband committing suicide around 2010 because his political party lost the elections that year. So sad how the demons are able to get people's hope in so many useless things! She was saved from Hinduism about 2000, her husband sometimes beating her for going to the church. She has 2 alcoholic sons, one son healed of liver damage at only 24 years old; but still he has no change of heart. Both their wives have left them. Oh GOD, heal her heart from a life of misery!

CHRISTIAN FOUNDATIONS

Psalms 11:3, "If the foundations are destroyed, What can the righteous do?" Satan knows that it is vital that Christians have a foundation in their walk with GOD. Just as a building cannot survive very long without a proper foundation, neither can a believer who has no proper Biblical or spiritual foundation.

Hebrews 6:1-2, "Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a **foundation** of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God...and eternal judgment." For lack of space, we'll just cover the "foundation" of repentance, faith and eternal judgment. We all know that faith is the starting point in any relationship with Christ, right? But what does faith PRODUCE within a believer's life? We read in James 2 that "faith without works is dead", and in Romans 2:4, "...not knowing that the kindness of GOD leads you to repentance?" A "faith" that does not result in some real level (though it may start out small) of repentance and the love of GOD (good works) is not true faith.

Why is "eternal judgment" part of the foundation? Because it helps produce the fear of GOD in our lives. "The fear of the Lord is the **beginning** of knowledge." Proverbs 1:7. Without the true fear of the Lord in our heart, how much "knowledge" or understanding of GOD do we have? How can we even interpret the Bible properly without the fear of GOD?

This isn't all-inclusive about Biblical foundations, but did you notice that the above foundations—repentance, eternal judgment, the fear of the Lord—all deal with keeping sin out of our lives? Any wonder Satan is trying to destroy the foundations? RHM is more geared toward helping the poor, but the purity of the ministry and Body of Christ is also a deep burden in my heart. CHILDREN'S PROFILES

SEBATI (9 years old, Morning Star Girls Home): This girl is from a poor tribal village. Her mother occasionally had "fits" (seizures). One night she began having seizures while her baby boy was tied to her body with a sheet (usually at the hip, a common tradition among the tribal women while they work, etc.). She eventually fell into a low-level water well nearby. Both she and the baby died. The father asked the Morning Star leaders to take his child into the girls home in 2012.



CHANDU (11 years old, HOPE): Chandu's father has some kind of mental instability and left the family about 10 years ago. The mother was not caring for Chandu properly, and because of poverty the grandparents also weren't able to care for him. As a 4 year old boy he was often wandering around the village, sleeping and eating wherever he could. When a child welfare worker visited the village, his neighbors were asking her to take this boy. She made request to HOPE, which took him into the home in 2010. He's naturally a little fearful, but a sweet-natured and friendly boy.
