Regular Meeting -----May 2, 1989

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, D. L. Taylor, at 7:00 A. M., at the District office. Other GCWCD Board members present were Gary Wilson and James Walker.

ATTENDANCE

Grand County Special Service Water District Board members present were Gary Wilson, D. L. Taylor, Bill McDougald and Dan Holyoak.

Others present were Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of April 18, 1989. After calling for additions or corrections, the Chair declared the minutes approved as read.

MINUTES

D. L. asked Dale to present his figures on Farnsworth's use of water. Dale stated Moab Irrigation has him take his water over the season, and he should spread his GCWCD water over the season too. It was asked if there was a minimum stream flow up there. This delivery on the mesa was discussed, and Dale reported his measuring device was non-functional. D. L. suggested we write Mark Page and ask him to the next meeting to address our concerns over the drought.

The pumping of the wells was discussed and Jim asked if the flow could be checked to make sure the meter is correct. Jim asked if the Parshall flume is still in Mrs. Walker's ditch. Dale stated he did not know.

Dale reported the total flow in the creek is still at 15 cfs with 6 cfs going through the tunnel. The level of the lake is dropping 3 inches per day. SVW's water use for April has doubled over last year at the same time. He has checked into various wells and whether they can be pumped to fields or that could be pumped into the system. He has asked UP&L for projected pumping costs for these wells. Dale feels the wells should be pumped to fields first. Question- should we prepare to pay for repairs to these wells, D.L. suggested if a well has been down 10 years, we should pay 10% of repairs. He is making plans to pump test the Corbin well. There is a pump test but not a

pump curve. Dan asked if there was not an 8" line to to the Holyoak ranch. Dale stated he had not run into any such pipeline but that he would check it out. We need to check to see if it would pump against pressure and to figure the cost of pumping that well. CORBIN WELL


Gary suggested that Beeman's, Carmichael's & Nightingale wells should be pumped to the fields now, so that the lake could have some time to recover. It was suggested Bill check with the City of Moab about the Corbin Well and golf course wells, and then meet with the other well owners to work out an agreement. Bill McDougald will talk to the other City Councilmen at the Council meeting tonight and if necessary, put us on the agenda for the next City Council meeting. WELLS TO BE PUMPED TO FIELDS
