A trio of Warriors led Berean Academy to its victory: Daniel Break, Chad Weibe and Roger Evans, who placed ninth, 10th and 11th, respectively.

The pivotal triumph in Berean's victory was Philip Veer's 21st-place finish, as he sprinted past Stanton County's Toby Huffman in the final 100 yards for what proved to be the winning margin.

Dale Larson of Riley County won a three-man sprint to the tape for the 2A boys' title, finishing in 10:27.7 — just three-tenths of a second ahead of Pernis Trantham of Macksville, who was a second ahead of Jesse Ybarra of Stanton County.

Roger Koester of Concordia captured the Class 4A boys' individual championship in 10:23.7 — the fastest time of the day.

Abilene claimed seventh place in the 4A boys' competition, won by Shawnee Aquinas, which edged second-place Colby, 54 to 55.

"When Colby placed two in the top five individually (Chad Bourquin and Joel Kriss), I was really beginning to worry," Aquinas head coach Terry Marshall said. "We haven't had consistent top-five performances all year."

Atwood, with five girls in the top 17, captured the Class 2A girls' crown, trimming Syracuse, 45-59.

"Our team has never been on the good end of it before," said Atwood coach Rhonda Argabright. "It's great to know that all the hard work we put in this year paid off in something as big as a state championship."

Kerry Stine of Pleasanton won the 2A girls' race.

In Class 1A, Wheatland's boys and Wakefield's girls justified their No. 1 rankings.

Wheatland topped runner-up Grinnell, 52-87, for its championship trophy as three Shockers placed in the top 10. It was the sixth consecutive state championship for Wheatland, the first time that's been accomplished in Kansas prep cross country history.

"We haven't done anything flashy all year, but we've been bunching them up in the pack real well," said Wheatland coach Layton Kaiser, whose top three finishers placed seventh, ninth and 10th.

"I was worried that the boys would feel the pressure of competing in a state meet, but they stayed loose and ran well. On a day like today, tightening up is your biggest worry. Fortunately, we were able to overcome
