## ***We Respond to God's Word***

**\*Affirmation of Faith (from The Second Helvetic Confession, 5.154):** Surely in the new covenant of Christ there is no longer any such priesthood as was under the ancient people; which had an external anointing, holy garments, and very many ceremonies which were types of Christ, who abolished them all by his coming and fulfilling them. But he himself remains the only priest forever, and lest we [take away] anything from him, we do not impart the name of priest to any minister. For the Lord himself did not appoint any priests in the Church of the New Testament who, having received authority from the [authorities], may daily offer up the sacrifice, that is, the very flesh and Blood of the Lord, for the living and the dead, but ministries Who may teach and administer the sacraments.

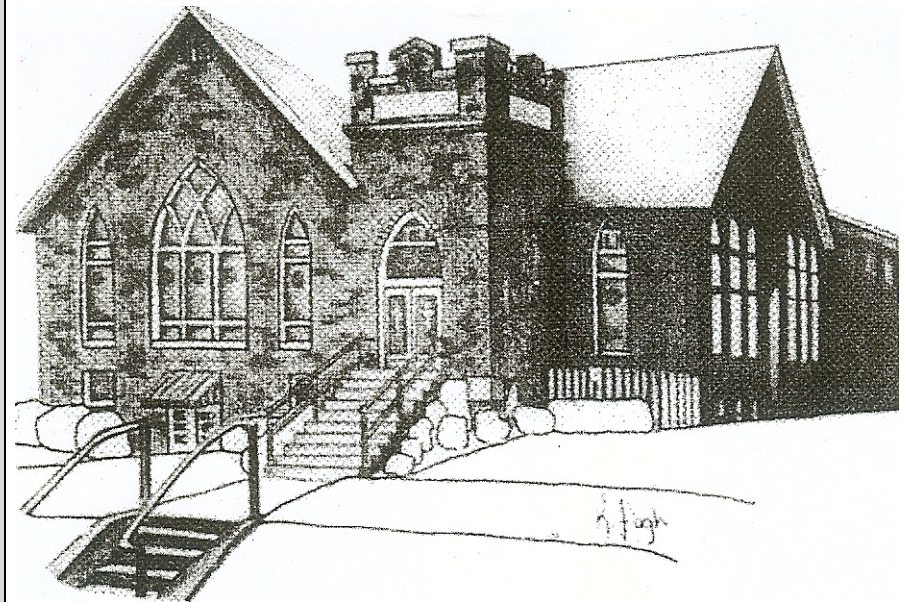
