# Christ Lutheran Church Newsletter



Aloha Kakou,

The Council Presidents of Christ Lutheran and Joy of Christ Lutheran Churches have asked me to report out to you regarding our meeting last night (Wednesday, January 28) regarding the potential partnering for Word and sacrament ministry (the formal definition of what an ordained Lutheran pastor "does").

The negotiated proposal that the leadership are bringing to their respective congregations is to partner for such ministry, with yours truly, being called to serve in that pastoral capacity.

Such a partnering always involves adjustments in the way everyone does things, and this partner-ship is no different. How much the pastor gets paid, who pays for how much of the pastor's defined compensation and benefits, whether and how administrative responsibilities are merged (or not), what shared and distinct potential ministries are possible, maintenance of each congregation's unique identity in these activities – all these areas of concern were discussed. And, it almost but not quite goes without saying – who worships at what time on Sunday, or for that matter any other day of the week.

Leadership explored a number of Sunday morning worship schedules, with advantages and disadvantages. Rev Tim Philips, Director of Evangelical Mission for the Pacifica Synod, attended and added helpful insights and ideas.

Here is the proposal as it emerged from the meeting:

Pastor Keith to be called to a full time position of Word and sacrament ministry

CLC to pay 60% of Pr Keith's defined compensation and benefits

JoC to pay 40% of Pr Keith's defined compensation and benefits

JoC to hold Sunday morning services at 9:00am

CLC to hold Sunday School at 9:15am

CLC to hold Sunday morning services at 10:45am

Pr Keith to preach and preside at both services

No supply pastors to be rotated in and out weekly

There is a good rationale for every bullet point in this summary, but time and space will not allow me to expound on them here. However, our goal is to be as transparent as possible, so that everyone who wishes may have opportunity to respond. AND until a congregational vote is taken and all of the interested parties, including you, the Bishop and me, sign off on this, nothing

is set in concrete.

Timeline for this to happen, is March 1<sup>st</sup>. To make that work, CLC is having a congregational meeting on Sunday, February 8<sup>th</sup> @ 9:15am. JoC has its annual meeting on Sunday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Pr Keith will be in attendance at both meetings.

Please, pray for our churches as we make some critical decisions regarding our work, worship and witness to Christ in our world.


Souper Bowl of Caring is dedicated to tackling all of the issues that exist in your communities, including poverty, hunger and homelessness.
