

FLOYD F. SNIDER

1902-1990

Floyd F. Snider, age 88 of Sand Point, passed away Tuesday, Nov. 27, at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe, after a short illness.

He was born June 22, 1902 in Chandler Township, son of the late Faldon and Eleanor (Wing) Snider. He was united in marriage to Lucille Benedict on July 26, 1937 in Midland. She preceded him in death March 8, 1984.

Mr. Snider was a 1921 graduate of Elkton High School. He attended the Practical Institute of Pharmacy, Sandusky and graduated from Chicago School of Watchmaking in 1924. He worked in Flint for a number of years with Cunningham Drug Stores.

On Jan. 1, 1948 Mr. Snider purchased Schiele Drug Store, Elkton, remaining there until 1957 when he went to Hospital Pharmacy, Pigeon. He retired in September 1967.

He is survived by one daughter, Ella Cook, Hillsdale; one son, Warren (Herma) Snider, Lake Orion; nine grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

Six brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services were conducted 1 p.m. Friday, Nov. 29 at Champagne Funeral Chapel, Caseville. The Rev. Greg Mayberry, pastor at Caseville United Methodist Church, officiated with burial in Colfax Township Cemetery.
